NEW HAMPSHIRE STATE COURT PROCEEDING ENJOINED AT COMMISSION'S REQUEST

The Boston Regional Office announced that Judge Martin F. Loughlin, U.S. District Court for the District of New Hampshire, granted the Commission's motion to enjoin a state court Interpleader Proceeding on May 21, 1984. The action grew out of an original civil action filed by the Commission against Richard J. Greenlaw of Henniker, New Hampshire on September 14, 1983. Greenlaw was charged in the complaint with violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws, and was permanently enjoined on November 18, 1983. Concomitant with granting the Commission's motion to enjoin the state court action, Judge Loughlin also granted the Commission's motion to appoint a receiver.

On March 26, 1984, Interpleader Proceedings began against several investors and the Commission in the Superior Court for the State of New Hampshire seeking to determine claims of investors. In enjoining the action, Judge Loughlin found that such an action was necessary to aid the federal court's jurisdiction and to effectuate the various orders of the court respecting freezing the defendant's assets and insuring the orderly course of the receivership. The Commission had argued, in seeking the injunction, that the state court action might inequitably satisfy only a few investors at the expense of all defrauded investors. (SEC v. Richard J. Greenlaw, Civil Action No. 83-557-L, DCNH, 1983). (LR-10403)
