INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

TRAVELERS EQUITIES FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 25 to request a hearing on an application by Travelers Equities Fund, Inc., a registered management company, for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-13990 - June 4)

PRUDENTIAL-BACHE SECURITIES INC.

LOUISIANA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
