U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

RULE REVISION AND RULE AMENDMENT

The Commission adopted a revision of Rule 70 and an amendment to Rule 50 under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935. The revision of Rule 70 would permit a limited number of investment bankers and commercial bankers to serve as officers or directors of public utility holding companies and their subsidiaries under certain conditions. This action is intended to simplify, and expand the exemptions now available under the existing rule. The amendment to Rule 50 addresses potential conflicts of interest which might arise shortly after an affiliated person of an investment banker leaves the board of directors of a company in a holding company system if that investment banker plays a significant role in the distribution of the securities of any company in the same system. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

INVESTMENT TRUST OF BOSTON

An application filed by Investment Trust of Boston, Moseley Capital Management Inc. and certain other entities for an order exempting them from certain provisions of Section 15(a) of the Investment Company Act, which was originally noticed on December 6, 1985 (Rel. IC-14832) and amended and restated on January 29, 1986, has been renoticed to give interested persons until March 28 to request a hearing on the application. (Rel. IC-14968 - March 5)

LEHMAN INSTITUTIONAL FUNDS TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 28 to request a hearing on an application filed by Lehman Institutional Funds Trust for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-14969 - March 5)

MERRILL LYNCH RETIREMENT/INCOME FUND, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Merrill Lynch Retirement/Income Fund, Inc. (formerly Merrill Lynch Retirement Benefit Government Securities Fund, Inc.) and any other registered mutual fund or series thereof, which may be managed or distributed by Merrill Lynch Asset Management, Inc. or its affiliates, to assess (and in certain cases waive) a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of their shares. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to issue options to purchase common stock and stock appreciation rights, and to issue and sell common stock under a stock option plan, not in excess of 1.5 million shares. (Rel. 35-24041 - March 5)

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 31 to request a hearing on a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Company, a registered holding company, to issue up to four million shares of its common stock, \$2.75 per value, for funding of its Long-Term Incentive Plan. (Rel. 35-24042 - March 5)

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 31 to request a hearing on a proposal by New England Electric System (NEES), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, New England Electric Transmission Corporation (NEET), for NEES to provide equity funds to NEET through capital contributions or the acquisition of NEET common stock. Additionally, NEES and NEET propose to obtain permanent financing for construction expenditures and have been granted an exception from competitive bidding to do so. (Rel. 35-24043 - March 5)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by Midwest Securities Trust Company (SR-MSTC-85-9) that establishes the MSTC Commercial Paper Division. (Rel. 34-22967)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-86-3) that deletes Part VIII, Schedule C of its by-laws. The deleted provisions stipulate that a person formerly associated with a broker-dealer registered under the SECO program may qualify for certain categories of registration with the NASD if that person's association with the SECO broker-dealer has not been terminated for two years or more prior to the date the NASD receives his application for registration. Because the SECO program was abolished more than two years ago, that exemption is no longer available.

Publication of the notice is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of March 3. (Rel. 34-22974)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

GEORGIA-PACIFIC CORPORATION

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on the application by Georgia-Pacific Corporation that the trusteeship of Chase Manhattan Bank N.A. under two indentures is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify Chase from acting as trustee.
