CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

AMERICAN SPORTS ADVISORS, INC. NAMED IN COMPLAINT

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on April 3 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against American Sports Advisors, Inc. of Garden City, New York. The complaint alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws and seeks a Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief.

The Commission alleges that American, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended October 27, 1985, and its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarter ended January 31, 1986, filed late Annual and Quarterly Reports, and failed to file Notifications of Late Filing. The Commission requests that the Court order American to file its delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports and enjoin it from further violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. American Sports Advisors, Inc., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 86-0901). (LR-11051)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

NADINE GAN SENTENCED

The Boston Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney in Massachusetts announced that on March 24 U.S. District Court Judge Frank H. Freedman sentenced Nadine Gan, of Chicopee, Massachusetts, to nine years in prison. On February 14, Gan pled guilty to 23 felony counts, including two counts of securities fraud.

The criminal action followed a Commission civil action filed in September 1981 in which Gan was permanently enjoined from further violations of the securities laws [SEC v. Nadine Gan, USDC DMA, 891-0261-F]. The Commission's action alleged that Gan offered and sold unregistered securities and engaged in fraudulent conduct in connection with the offer, purchase and sale of the securities by, among other things, selling approximately \$2.5 million in unregistered securities in the form of investment contracts, namely shares in investment clubs, to over 150 investors in at least six states. Additionally, the complaint alleged that Gan misrepresented material facts and omitted to state material facts concerning, among other things, commingling, conversion and diversion of proceeds, the source of funds used to pay off investors, profits to be realized by investors, and the guarantee against loss of investors funds. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MERRILL LYNCH PACIFIC FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 29 to request a hearing on an application filed by Merrill Lynch Pacific Fund, Inc., a registered open-end, diversified, management investment company, requesting an order exempting it from Section 12(d)(3) of the Investment Company Act respecting its purchase of securities of certain major Japanese securities firms. (Rel. IC-15039 - April 4)

DELAWARE FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 29 to request a hearing on an application for an order permitting existing and future investment companies advised by Delaware Management Company or affiliates or subsidiaries thereof to deposit daily cash balances remaining uninvested at the end of each trading day into a single joint account for the purpose of entering into one or more large repurchase agreements. WITHDRAWAL GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of MARSHALL INDUSTRIES to withdraw its common stock, \$1.00 par value, from listing and registration on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-23100)

An order has been issued granting the application of the Pacific Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of one issue which is listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges. (Rel. 34-23101)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-86-3) which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A). The proposal adds new Interpretive and Policy .01 to OCC Rule 614 that enables OCC to establish a pilot program allowing clearing members to pledge non-equity options. (Rel. 34-23097)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-86-8) to amend its facilities description for its Small Order Execution System (SOES) to allocate unpreferred orders only to those market-makers whose quotations are at or nearest the NASDAQ best bid or offer, and to allow self-preferencing of SOES orders.

Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of April 7. (Rel. 34-23099)
