INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BOETTCHER & COMPANY, INC.

INDIANA & MICHIGAN ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Indiana & Michigan Electric Company, subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., to issue and sell up to \$200 million of its first mortgage bonds by competitive bidding. In the alternative, it proposes to enter into a revolving credit or term loan agreement to issue notes in the same principal amount outstanding at any given time.
