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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### MICHAEL LEVINSON & COMPANY, OTHERS CITED

The New York Regional Office announced that in administrative proceedings ordered under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Michael Levinson & Company, Inc. (Registrant), its president and secretary and treasurer, respectively, Michael Levinson and John Finnell, submitted Offers of Settlement, which the Commission accepted. Registrant, Levinson and Finnell, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to Findings and Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions which find that Registrant wilfully violated, and Levinson and Finnell wilfully aided and abetted Registrant's violations of, the net capital, bookkeeping and reporting provisions of the Exchange Act.

The Commission revoked Registrant's registration as a broker or dealer and barred Levinson and Finnell from association with any broker-dealer in any proprietary capacity and in any supervisory capacity respecting financial, bookkeeping and back office functions. Levinson and Finnell may apply to become associated in such capacity after two and three years, respectively, from the date of the Order. (Rel. 34-23295)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST WORLDWIDE VENTURES CORP., OTHERS

The Commission filed on June 11 an action for injunctive and other equitable relief in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against Worldwide Ventures Corp., its chairman, George Livieratos, its former president, Lorenzo Formato, Norbay Securities, Inc., Norbay's president, Benjamin J. Taormina (B. Taormina), Norbay's compliance officer, Stephen J. Taormina (S. Taormina), the former assistant branch manager of Norbay's Rector Street office, Gary M. Wertman and the former principal of Decker Zender Pelman & Co. (DZP), David J. Decker.

In its complaint, the Commission alleged that: the defendants violated antifraud provisions of the securities laws by engaging in fraudulent conduct which was intended to artificially raise the price of Worldwide stock; Worldwide, aided and abetted by Livieratos and Formato, violated the reporting provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934; Livieratos, Formato, Norbay and B. Taormina violated registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933; Norbay violated a recordkeeping provision of the Exchange Act; and Formato violated a previous Order of the Commission issued against him.

In addition to injunctive relief, the Commission also seeks an order requiring Livieratos to account for and disgorge all profits which he garnered from his improper transactions. (SEC v. Worldwide Ventures Corp., et. al., USDC SDNY, Civil Action No. 86-Civ. 4604 [VLB]). (LR-11123)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### MOSELEY SECURITIES CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 7 to request a hearing on an application by Moseley Securities Corporation, formerly Moseley, Hallgarten, Estabrook & Weeden, Inc., and its affiliated companies, for an order exempting them from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Investment Company Act. The Commission has also granted Moseley a temporary exemption from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Act and granted the Commission Secretary authority to issue an order of permanent exemption if no request for a hearing is filed. Notices have been issued giving interested persons until June 26 to request a hearing on an application by Finomic Investment Fund Inc. and BuildAmerica Government Securities Trust for an order declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-15136; IC-15137 - June 6)

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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### OHIO POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued regarding Ohio Power Company, subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., and its coal-mining subsidiaries, authorizing the coal companies to lease mining equipment with an aggregate acquisition cost not exceeding \$16.5 million from a nonassociated company and Ohio Power to guarantee the payments of one of the coal-mining subsidiaries. ### GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company, to guarantee the performance of office lease obligations by its subsidiary GPU Nuclear Corporation. (Rel. 35-24121 - June 9)

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Amex-86-15) to introduce a new, European-style broad market index option contract. The new contract, called the Institutional Index Option, is to be composed of the 75 stocks most favored by institutional investors.

Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of June 16. (Rel. 34-23311)

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Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
