## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

---

### I.M. SIMON & COMPANY, INC., OTHERS CITED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against I.M. Simon & Company, Inc., Joseph Elmendorf and Richard Kluesner. Simultaneously, I.M. Simon and its operations manager and comptroller, Elmendorf and Kluesner, respectively, submitted Offers of Settlement. Respondents, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to an order which finds that I.M. Simon, aided and abetted by Elmendorf and Kluesner, violated Sections 15(c)(3) and 17(a) of the Securities Exchange Act and several rules related to customer protection, books and records, and financial reporting requirements. Additionally, I.M. Simon consented to findings that it violated Rule 10b-10 by failing to disclose yield to maturity to customers purchasing Certificates of Accrual Treasury Securities.

The Commission censured I.M. Simon and suspended Elmendorf and Kluesner from association in a supervisory capacity with any broker-dealer for six months and four months, respectively. On August 26, Elmendorf and Kluesner consented to permanent injunctions enjoining them from aiding and abetting violations of the above provisions [see LR-11209]. (Rel. 34-23592)

## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

---

### RUSSELL A. PHIPPS PLEADS GUILTY

Robert C. Bonner, U.S. Attorney for the Central District of California, and the Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on August 14 Russell A. Phipps pleaded guilty to four counts of securities fraud, eight counts of mail fraud, and three counts of interstate transportation of property taken by fraud, after a four-week jury trial. The indictment alleged that Phipps misappropriated at least \$440,000 from his clients, from approximately December 1980 through at least January 1984. At the time, Phipps was a stockbroker in Long Beach, California. Phipps is scheduled to appear for sentencing before U.S. District Judge J. Spencer Letts on September 26. (U.S. v. Russell A. ### FSA CAPITAL, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 2 to request a hearing on an application by Suncoast Finance Corporation for an order exempting Suncoast and certain trusts created by it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-15292 - Sept. 9)

### CENTENNIAL GOVERNMENT TRUST; CENTENNIAL TAX EXEMPT TRUST

## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P), subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, to: (a) modify the terms of the common stock dividend restriction in the indenture that will apply to the issue and sale of \$100 million principal amount of first and refunding mortgage bonds authorized to be issued and sold in a prior Commission order (Rel. 35-23852, October 2, 1985); and (b) to add two series of bonds to those authorized to be refunded in the prior order. ## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

---

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval of a proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-86-17) to extend for an additional six months the stock options pilot program providing for four expiration months, including two near term months, instead of quarterly expiration cycles. (Rel. 34-23598)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-86-12) which converts all OCC money settlements to same-day funds settlements. (Rel. 34-23601)

### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Pacific Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-PSE-86-10) to permit its Order Book Officials to disclose to exchange members the price and number of contracts on the book that are bidden below or offered above the displayed market quote. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of September 8. (Rel. 34-23603)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
