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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND  
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

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### FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST JOHN M. CARPENTER

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on December 9 U.S. District Judge James C. Paine, Southern District of Florida, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against John M. Carpenter of Boca Raton, Florida. Carpenter was formerly employed by a New York Stock Exchange member firm in the firm's Lighthouse Point, Florida office. The Final Judgment enjoins Carpenter from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and requires that Carpenter file, within 60 days, an accounting of proceeds received pursuant to the schemes described in the Commission's complaint.

The August 6 complaint alleges that the defendants engaged in a "ponzi scheme" and obtained money from investors by, among other misrepresentations, falsely stating that funds invested were being used to purchase municipal bonds for individual investors' accounts or participatory interests in a pool of municipal bonds in an account controlled by the defendants. The complaint further alleges that the defendants made payments to investors, purportedly representing interest earned, with funds which were misappropriated from later investors. (SEC v. John G. Kenning and John M. Carpenter, Civil Action No. 86-6633-CIV-PAINE, SDFL). (LR-11316)

### PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST ISLAND RESOURCES, INC.

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on December 11 U.S. District Judge Kenneth Ryskamp, Southern District of Florida, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Island Resources, Inc., a New York corporation located in Briarcliff, New York. Island, without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint, consented to the Final Judgment.

The Final Judgment enjoins Island from violating the reporting, books and records, and accounting controls provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The September 24 complaint alleges that Island failed to file with the Commission timely and accurate annual, current, and periodic reports and failed to maintain accurate books and records. The complaint further alleges that Island failed to maintain required accounting controls by, among other things, failing to establish and utilize procedures to accurately record disbursements of company funds and failing to adequately segregate the functions of disbursing funds and recording the disbursement of funds. (SEC v. Michael J. Hannan, et al., Civil Action No. 86-8542-CIV-RYSKAMP, SDFL). (LR-11317)

### CIVIL ACTION SETTLED RE JOHN DIAS

The Commission announced the settlement on December 3 of a civil action instituted on June 10 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against John Dias, chief financial officer of Automatix Incorporated in Massachusetts. The complaint alleged that in 1983 Automatix, at the direction of Dias, followed revenue recognition practices which were not in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, and thus overstated revenue from equipment sales. Without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint, Dias consented to a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction permanently enjoining him from aiding and abetting violations of Sections 13(a), 13(b)(2)(A), 13(b)(2)(B), and 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. (SEC v. John Dias, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 86-1597). (LR-11319)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### JODE LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

An order has been issued on an application filed by JODE Limited Partnership (Fund), a limited partnership organized for partners and certain senior management employees of Kutak Rock & Campbell, and JODE, Inc., its general partner, exempting the Fund from all provisions of the Investment Company Act with certain exceptions, and granting confidential treatment. (Rel. IC-15495 - Dec. 23)

## ASSOCIATION OF PUBLICLY TRADED INVESTMENT FUNDS

An order has been issued amending a prior order issued June 21, 1985 (Rel. IC-14594) by the Association of Publicly Traded Investment Funds to permit its internally-managed members to have profit-sharing employee retirement plans qualified under Section 401(a) of the Internal Revenue Code. (Rel. IC-15496 - Dec. 23)

## OHIO NATIONAL LIFE ASSURANCE CORPORATION

An order has been issued for Ohio National Life Assurance Corporation, et al., granting exemptions from Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c), 27(c)(1) and 27(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-3(T)(b)(12), (b)(13), (c)(2) and (c)(4), and 22c-1 to the extent necessary to issue flexible premium variable life insurance contracts, as defined in paragraph (c)(1) of Rule 6e-3(T), which provide for the waiver of future premiums upon disability of the insured and for a contingent deferred administrative expense charge. (Rel. IC-15497 - Dec. 23)

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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### NEW ENGLAND POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing New England Power Company, subsidiary of New England Electric System, to incur obligations in connection with the issuance and sale of up to \$35 million of pollution control revenue bonds. (Rel. 35-24270 - Dec. 18)

### ARKANSAS POWER & LIGHT COMPANY; THE NARRAGANSETT ELECTRIC COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until January 12, 1987 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24271, dated December 18: Arkansas Power & Light Company - subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to guarantee the workers' compensation liabilities of its subsidiary, Associated Natural Gas Company, as required by Missouri law, and to issue such further guarantees of these liabilities as may be required through December 31, 1990; and The Narragansett Electric Company - subsidiary of New England Electric System, to acquire any or all of its outstanding first mortgage bonds, Series P, which aggregate \$40 million, and to issue and sell new first mortgage bonds to finance said acquisition.

### GRANITE STATE ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Granite State Electric Company, subsidiary of New England Electric System, to issue and sell to an institutional investor, on or before December 31, 1987, a long-term promissory note(s) in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$5 million, under a Note Agreement. Granite has been granted an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50, under Rule 50(a)(5) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act. (Rel. 35-24272 - Dec. 18)
