NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

Following is a schedule of Commission meetings which will be conducted pursuant to provisions of the Government in the Sunshine Act. In general, the Commission expects to follow a schedule of holding closed meetings on Tuesdays, and open meetings on Thursday morning. Meetings on Wednesday, and if necessary on Thursday afternoons, will be either open or closed according to the requirements of agenda items under consideration. The Commission will not normally meet on Mondays or Fridays.

Visitors are welcome at all open meetings, insofar as space is available.

Meetings will be held in the Commission Meeting Room on the eighth floor of the Commission's headquarters building at 500 North Capitol Street, Washington, D.C. All visitors are required to sign in and obtain passes at the Reception Desk in the lobby. Persons wishing to photograph or videotape Commission meetings must obtain permission in advance from the Secretary of the Commission. Persons wishing to tape record a Commission meeting should notify the Secretary's office 48 hours in advance of the meeting.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT SCHEDULE OF SEC OFFICE MOVE

Public Reference Room To Close 2-1/2 Days for July 23rd Move - The Public Reference Room is scheduled to move to Room 1024 of the Commission's new building at 450 Fifth St., N.W., Washington, D.C. 20549 the weekend of July 23. The magnitude of moving the Public Reference Room, where most public documents required to be filed with the SEC by public corporations and others are made available to the public, will necessitate the closing of the Reference Room from noon Thursday, July 22, through Monday, July 26. It will reopen at the new building at 9:00 a.m. Tuesday, July 27.

During the two and one-half days Public Reference is closed, persons requiring reports filed on Schedules 13D and 14D should make arrangements with the Office of Consumer

Affairs and Information Services (Phone: 202-523-3952). (Schedules 13D and 14D are filed with the SEC by companies and individuals if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest exceeds five percent.)

Office of Public Affairs Will Move July 24-25 Weekend - During the weekend of July 24-25, the Office of Public Affairs, where the Press Room is located and new releases may be obtained, will move to the new headquarters building at 450 Fifth Street, N.W. The office will open at 9:00 a.m. Monday, July 26, in Room 1015 of the new address (Phone: 202-272-2650). There will be no interruption in service.

Document Control (Filing Room) Will Move July 31-August 1 - During the weekend of July 31-August 1, the Document Control Branch will move to Room 1005 of the Commission's new headquarters (Phone: 202-272-2624). Document Control is the office that accepts and processes filings that corporations, broker-dealers and individuals are required to make with the Commission. The office will reopen Monday, August 2, at 8:00 a.m. in the new building. (It is open 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., an hour longer than other Commission offices.) There will be no interruption in service.

ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

Below is a list of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the prior percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update, or revision.
