U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

THE EQUILINK CORPORATION ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on January 27 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against The Equilink Corporation of East Rutherford, New Jersey, restraining and enjoining Equilink from failing to file timely periodic reports and ordering it to comply with certain undertakings. Equilink, consented to the entry of the Court's Judgment, acknowledged that it had filed reports in an untimely manner on 11 occasions. Equilink has agreed to adopt certain procedures to assure timely filing of reports required to be filed under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. (SEC v. The Equilink Corporation, U.S.D.C. D.C., Civil Action No. 82-3503). (LR-9881)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES
