PROCEEDINGS AGAINST JOHN BRYANT MEAUX, JR. DISCONTINUED

At the request of the Division of Enforcement, which has been unable to effect service of the order for proceedings on John Bryant Meaux, Jr., formerly of Beaumont, Texas, the Commission has discontinued its proceedings against Meaux, without prejudice to their re-institution on the basis of the same allegations. AGGRESSIVE GROWTH SHARES, INC.

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
