INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GEICO MUNICIPAL SECURITIES SERIES TRUST

An order has been issued exempting GEICO Municipal Securities Series Trust, a registered management investment company, from Sections 2(a)(41) and 12(d)(3) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 and Rules 2a-4 and 22c-1 thereunder, in connection with the acquisition and valuation of stand-by commitments by one of its series, GEICO Tax-Free Cash Fund. (Rel. IC-13504 - Sept. 16)

UNION BANK OF SWITZERLAND

An order has been issued on an application of Union Bank of Switzerland and its wholly-owned subsidiary, UBS Finance (Delaware) Inc., under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act of 1940, exempting them from all provisions of the Act so that they may offer and sell commercial paper in the United States. RACZ MULTI-EQUITY GROWTH FUND, INC. RACZ STRATEGIC METALS EQUITY FUND, INC.

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The following have filed proposed rule changes under Rule 19b-4: The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-NYSE-83-37) - to provide for the cover of short options positions, including index option positions, by use of bank letters of guarantee meeting certain requirements (Rel. 34-20184); The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. (SR-CBOE-83-31) - to provide for cover of short index call option positions through delivery

of an Index Option Escrow Receipt which, among other things, is backed by at least ten qualifying securities having a total value at least equal to the aggregate index value (Rel. 34-20188); and The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-83-13) - which would amend MSRB Rules G-12 and G-15. The proposed rule change would require municipal securities dealers that participate (directly or through clearing agents) in registered clearing agencies offering automated comparison services for municipal securities to submit to those clearing agencies trade data respecting inter-dealer municipal securities transactions. The proposed rule change would also require municipal securities dealers, brokers and customers that participate (directly or through agents) in registered securities depositories to use automated depository facilities to confirm and acknowledge trades that are to be settled by delivery-against-payment or receipt-against-payment. The comparison/confirmation requirements would apply to all trades by affected persons in municipal securities issues that have been assigned CUSIP numbers. Finally, the proposed rule change would require these affected persons to settle their securities delivery obligations by book-entry movements at those clearing agencies if the trades involve securities eligible for deposit at the relevant clearing agency (Rel. 34-20189).

Publication of the above proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of September 19.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-Phlx-83-10) to require brokers, traders, specialists and clearing firms to have representatives available on the floor during specified times to make trade corrections and changes.
