RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

ADOPTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO RULE 10b-4

The Commission adopted an amendment to Rule 10b-4 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, the short tendering rule. The amendment is intended to prohibit hedged tendering through the writing of in-the-money call options. The Commission also withdrew a proposed amendment that would have required persons tendering by guarantee to deliver all guaranteed shares. (Rel. 34-21782)

RULE 203(b)(3)-1 PROPOSED FOR COMMENT

The Commission proposes for public comment Rule 203(b)(3)-1 under the Investment Company Act of 1940. The proposed rule would specify certain situations in which a limited partnership, rather than each of its limited partners, would be counted as a "client" of a general partner acting as investment adviser to the partnership, for purposes of an exemption from registration provided by the Investment Advisers Act.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PMG HOUSING PARTNERS 1984-III

An order has been issued exempting PMG Housing Partners 1984-III, a California limited partnership, from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14386 - Feb. 20)

RETIREMENT PLANNING FUNDS OF AMERICA, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 18 to request a hearing on an application of Retirement Planning Funds of America, Inc. for an order amending a prior Commission order to permit modification of its contingent deferred sales charge program. The application would also permit certain additional offers of exchange at other than relative net asset value. (Rel. IC-14387 - Feb. 20)

MERRILL LYNCH KECALP GROWTH INVESTMENTS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP 1983

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 18 to request a hearing on an application filed by Merrill Lynch KECALP Growth Investments Limited Partnership 1983, KECALP, Inc., Merrill Lynch Private Capital Inc. and Merrill Lynch & Co., Inc. for an order exempting them from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act and permitting certain affiliated transactions. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 18 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central and South West Corporation, and its subsidiary, CSW Energy, Inc., to permit sales of cogenerated electric power to additional parties. (Rel. 35-23611 - Feb. 21)

NEW ORLEANS PUBLIC SERVICE INC.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by New Orleans Public Service Inc. (NOPSI), and its parent, Middle South Utilities, Inc. (MSU), for NOPSI to sell up to \$40 million in principal amount of its first mortgage bonds; up to \$20 million of its serial preferred stock, par value \$100; and for the issuance and sale to MSU of up to four million shares of NOPSI's common stock, \$10 par value, at a price of \$10 per share. TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

JOSEPH E. SEAGRAM & SONS, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 7 to request a hearing on an amended application by Joseph E. Seagram & Sons, Inc. (JES) and The Seagram Company, Ltd. under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 (the original notice was dated January 17, 1985).
