NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

Following is a schedule of Commission meetings which will be conducted pursuant to provisions of the Government in the Sunshine Act. In general, the Commission expects to follow a schedule of holding closed meetings on Tuesdays, and open meetings on Thursday morning. Meetings on Wednesday, and if necessary on Thursday afternoons, will be either open or closed according to the requirements of agenda items under consideration. The Commission will not normally meet on Mondays or Fridays.

Visitors are welcome at all open meetings, insofar as space is available.

Meetings will be held in the Commission Meeting Room, Room 1C30, at the Commission's headquarters building, 450 Fifth Street, N.W., Washington, DC. Persons wishing to photograph or videotape Commission meetings must obtain permission in advance from the Secretary of the Commission. Persons wishing to tape record a Commission meeting should notify the Secretary's office 48 hours in advance of the meeting.

OPEN MEETING - MONDAY, MARCH 18, 1985 - 2:30 p.m.

The subject matter of the March 18 open meeting will be:

Consideration of whether to propose for public comment amendments to Rule 15c3-3 under Section 15(c)(3) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposed amendments will, for purposes of the debit items of the Reserve Formula, exclude: (1) the debt balances of household members and other persons related to broker-dealer principals or affiliated in a certain way with a broker-dealer; (2) under certain circumstances, the debit balances of accounts in which "principals" of a broker-dealer have ownership interests; and (3) the amount by which a broker-dealer's margin account receivable with a single customer exceeds 25 percent of tentative net capital of the broker-dealer. The net effect of the proposed amendments may be to require that greater deposits be made on the Reserve Bank Accounts of some broker dealers. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

MARSAN SECURITIES CO., INC. DEFAULTS

The Commission, in administrative proceedings ordered under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, issued Findings and Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions by Default against Marsan Securities Co., Inc. Marsan, a registered broker-dealer, failed to answer the Order for Public Proceedings and, therefore, was in default.

On the basis of the Order for Public Proceedings, the Commission found Marsan wilfully violated the net capital, customer protection, recordkeeping, financial reporting, supplemental reporting, confirmation and amendment of Form BD provisions of the Exchange Act and the rules thereunder. The Commission ordered that Marsan's registration as a broker-dealer be revoked. (Rel. 34-21787)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE GOLDEN CORRAL POOLING GROUP

ORDER DENYING SECOND REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION

The Commission denied the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc.'s (NASD) November 19, 1984 motion for reconsideration of Commission findings respecting a fee dispute between the NASD and the Institutional Networks Corporation. (Rel. 34-21832)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-85-3) which would amend its Rule 1014(c)(i)(A) to clarify which bid-ask differentials are applicable to options series of less than nine months, and options series of more than nine months, in conformity with Phlx Rule 1012 which permits the trading of foreign currency options series with a 12-month expiration period. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of March 11. (Rel. 34-21833)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

JOSEPH E. SEAGRAM AND SONS, INC.

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Joseph E. Seagram and Sons, Inc. and The Seagram Company, Ltd. that the trusteeship of The Bank of New York under two indentures is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify The Bank of New York from acting as trustee under the indenture. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
