## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### LARRY HAM ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office filed a complaint on May 22 in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, seeking a permanent injunction against Larry Ham of Sarasota, Florida.

The complaint alleges that from 1981 through June 1983, Ham was a co-partner in Larmax Oil, an oil exploration partnership formerly located in Rolling Meadows, Illinois. In this capacity, Ham offered and sold unregistered securities, namely, fractional undivided working interests in oil leases. In connection with the sale of these securities, the complaint alleges that Ham made misrepresentations and omitted to state certain material facts concerning the use of proceeds, the risks involved, anticipated production, and his past drilling history.

On May 24, U.S. District Judge John Nordberg entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Ham, which he consented to without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations. (SEC v. Larry Ham, NDIL, Civil Action No. 85C04955). (LR-10768)
