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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### COMMISSION SUBMITS AMICUS MEMORANDUM ON MATERIALITY OF MERGER TALKS

The Commission filed on July 24 in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit a Memorandum, amicus curiae, in connection with a pending petition for rehearing. The Commission reiterates its long-standing view, which it notes has traditionally been accepted by the courts, that merger negotiations by publicly-held companies may be material, and may in certain situations have to be disclosed, well before there is agreement on price and structure. Materiality, the Commission states, must be determined on the facts of each case. The Commission urges the Seventh Circuit to modify or delete dictum from its July 3 decision in Michaels v. Michaels, in which it stated that merger talks by publicly-held companies do not become material until agreement has been reached on price and structure, accepting the materiality standard articulated by the Third Circuit in Greenfield v. Heublein. Although the Court refused to apply Greenfield in the case before it, which involved a privately-held company, the Commission argues that the Greenfield test is an incorrect one which could allow insiders in publicly-held companies to trade with shareholders without furnishing them information about even fairly advanced negotiations. 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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST WILLIAM O. HENDERSON AND HENDERSON, INC.

The Commission rejected settlement offers submitted by William Orr Henderson and Henderson, Inc. (Respondents) and issued an Order for public administrative proceedings against them to include as additional bases permanent injunctions and criminal convictions of Respondents under Sections 203(e)(2)(A), (B) and (C) and 203(e)(3) of the Advisers Act.

On February 14, 1984, the Commission authorized the institution of administrative proceedings and the filing of an injunction against Respondents based on violations of antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act and Rule 10(b)(5) and Sections 206(1), (2) and (4) of the Advisers Act and Rule 206(4), and authorized the staff to negotiate settlement before instituting the administrative proceedings. On March 16, 1984, the U.S. District Court in Tucson, Arizona entered permanent injunctions against Respondents and, on April 19, 1984, Respondents pled guilty to three Arizona felony counts of fraudulent scheme and artifice.

The Commission's Order alleges that the Respondents misappropriated their clients' funds under the pretext of purchasing certificates of deposit and limited partnership interests on their behalf.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine the truth of the allegations and the appropriate sanctions, if any. (Rel. 34-22242)

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## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

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### CITICORP

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 22 to request a hearing on an application by Citicorp under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of the United States Trust Company of New York under four existing indentures, and two Pooling and Servicing Agreements dated May 1, 1985 under which certificates evidencing interests in a pool of mortgage loans have been issued, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify Trust Company from acting as trustee.

The Trust Company currently is acting as trustee under the following four indentures: (a) dated February 15, 1982, involving the issuance of floating rate notes, due 1989; (2) dated March 15, 1977, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes; (3) dated August 25, 1977, involving the issuance of rising-rate notes, Series A; and (4) dated April 21, 1980, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes.
