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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER FREEZING ASSETS ENTERED

The Fort Worth Regional Office filed a complaint on December 11 in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas against Comstock Financial Services, Inc., Preferred Financial Consultants, Ltd., Abraham Boldt, Roy L. Comstock, David L. Wiksell, Charles H. Baldwin, Charles W. Huber, Billy C. Burdine and Hitech Recovery System, Inc. The complaint alleges violations of the securities and broker-dealers registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. On December 12 Judge A. Joe Fish entered an Order temporarily restraining the defendants from violations of the aforementioned provisions and from disposing of assets or other properties until further order of the court. The complaint further seeks an accounting and disgorgement of illegal profits from the defendants as well as preliminary and permanent injunctions to prohibit future violations of the securities laws.

The complaint alleges that the defendants sold over \$9 million of securities in the form of investment contracts to at least 600 investors in 13 states. The complaint also alleges misappropriation and misapplication of the \$9 million raised by defendants. Allegedly a large portion of these funds were converted by the individual defendants. (SEC v. Comstock Financial Services, Inc., USDC NDTX, Dallas Division, CA 3-85-2498-G). (LR-10964)

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## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

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### PARADYNE CORPORATION, OTHERS INDICTED

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on December 12 a federal grand jury sitting in Tampa, Florida returned an indictment against Paradyne Corporation, its president and chief executive officer, Robert Wiggins, and certain of its officers, directors and others. The indictment charges that Paradyne and individual defendants conspired to impede, impair and obstruct the Social Security Administration (SSA) in its operation and administration of contracts by submitting false statements to SSA concerning contracts it awarded to Paradyne, including an \$84 million contract to supply computer equipment. This contract was the largest contract ever awarded to Paradyne or by SSA.

The indictment charges that: the defendants misrepresented that the Paradyne computer system had been developed and was available for delivery as of August 7, 1980; the equipment Paradyne demonstrated at an operational capabilities demonstration was the same as the system Paradyne had proposed in its bid; in response to a bid protest, defendants stated that the system was commercially available and had been formally announced by Paradyne by the time it submitted its bid; certain defendants lied to the Commission in depositions conducted by the agency; and Paradyne bribed a SSA official. Orders have been issued exempting The National Mutual Life Association of Australasia Limited and National Mutual Group Finance Ltd, and Kleinwort, Benson Limited, an English merchant bank, and Kleinwort Benson U.S. Finance, Incorporated, its subsidiary, from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. ## INTERWEST CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 17, 1986 to request a hearing on an application by Interwest Corporation, formerly Overseas Securities Co., Inc., for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-14874 - Dec. 24)

## SOCIETE GENERALE (CANADA)

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 17, 1986 to request a hearing on an application by Societe Generale (Canada) for an order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in its proposed issuance of debt securities in the United States. 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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NYSE-85-46) to modify certain rates set forth in Rules 451 and 465 as reasonable rates of reimbursement for the forwarding of proxy and annual report mailings to beneficial shareowners.

Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of December 30. (Rel. 34-22740)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-NYSE-85-11) to establish an interpretation to NYSE Rule 304A (Member and Allied Member Examination Requirements) requiring allied members to satisfy the examination requirement under this rule by passing an examination acceptable to the Exchange pertaining to the applicant's specific job responsibilities, unless the Exchange determines that a waiver of the examination is appropriate. 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## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

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### J.C. PENNEY COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 21, 1986 to request a hearing on an application by J.C. Penney Company under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the proposed successor trusteeship of Chemical Bank (Trust Company) under an existing indenture, and the trusteeship of Chemical Bank under four other existing indentures are not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify Chemical Bank from as trustee under the following four indentures dated: (1) June 15, 1980, involving the issuance of 11.50% sinking fund debentures, due 2010; (2) June 15, 1980, involving the issuance of 10.75% notes, due 1990; (3) May 1, 1981, involving the

issuance of 6% debentures, due 2006; and (4) May 1, 1981, involving the issuance of zero coupon notes, due 1989. The successor trusteeship is for an indenture dated July 15, 1970, involving the issuance of 8-7/8% sinking fund debentures, due 1995. (Ref. TI-1058)
