ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

DEFAULT JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST ERNEST FITZGERALD AND COMPUTERIZED TAX SERVICE, INC.

The Commission announced that on March 16 the Honorable Robert H. Hall, United States District Judge for the Northern District of Georgia, entered a final judgment of default permanently enjoining Ernest Leland Fitzgerald (Fitzgerald) and Computerized Tax Service, Inc. (CTS) from future violations of Sections 5 and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Sections 10(b) and 15(a)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5 and 10b-9 thereunder, and Sections 203(a), 206(1) and 206(2) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. The final judgment orders the defendants to disgorge \$12,073,506, the sum which Fitzgerald and CTS fraudulently obtain from investors, and \$645,016.31 in prejudgment interest thereon. The default judgment also orders that civil penalties in the amounts of \$179,050 and \$1,559,947 be set against Fitzgerald and CTS, respectively. The Commission's complaint alleges that from at least 1989 through 1992, Fitzgerald and CTS sold securities to investors in several states making numerous misrepresentations and omissions of material facts to investors, including, among others, that investor proceeds were not invested as represented but were commingled and converted to the use of Fitzgerald and CTS, who received \$838,000 and \$3.7 million, respectively. The complaint also alleges that Fitzgerald obtained monies from investors to purchase securities in individual retirement accounts at a registered broker-dealer and never opened such accounts. CIVIL ACTION AGAINST LEONARD SANDS, ET AL.

The Commission today announced that on April 6 Judge Davies of the United States District Court for the Central District of California issued a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction enjoining Berrien E. Moore, without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint, from future violations of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder and causing or aiding and abetting violations of Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rule 13a-1 thereunder. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MERRILL LYNCH ADJUSTABLE RATE SECURITIES FUND, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Merrill Lynch Adjustable Rate Securities Fund, Inc., et al. from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order permits applicants to issue an unlimited number of classes of shares, assess a contingent deferred sales charge (CDSC) on certain redemptions of shares and waive the CDSC in certain instances. LUTHERAN BROTHERHOOD HIGH YIELD FUND LUTHERAN BROTHERHOOD INCOME FUND, INC. LUTHERAN BROTHERHOOD MONEY MARKET FUND LUTHERAN BROTHERHOOD MUNICIPAL BOND FUND, INC. LUTHERAN BROTHERHOOD OPPORTUNITY GROWTH FUND

Orders have been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that the above-named companies have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-20212, IC-20213, IC-20214, IC-20215 and IC-20216, respectively - April 12)

AETNA SERIES FUND, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Aetna Series Fund, Inc., et al. under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f)(1), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order permits certain investment companies to issue multiple classes of shares and assess a contingent deferred sales charge. (Rel. IC-20217 - April 13)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-89-16) filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers relating to specifications and study outline for the Registered Options Limited Representative Examination. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 18. (Rel. 34-33892)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-CHX-93-28) filed by the Chicago Stock Exchange to amend its Charter, Constitution and rules relating to corporate governance issues. (Rel. 34-33901)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved on an accelerated basis a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-92-13) filed by The Options Clearing Corporation that amends the valuation rate applied to securities deposited as clearing margin. (Rel. 34-33893)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-94-19) to provide the NASD with the discretionary authority to impose additional or more stringent criteria for inclusion of securities in Nasdaq. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 18. (Rel. 34-33899)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change (SR-AMEX-94-10) filed by the American Stock Exchange relating to the minimum fractional change for trading in Standard & Poor's Depository Receipts has become effective upon filing. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 18. (Rel. 34-33900)

A proposed rule change (SR-NASD-94-21) filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers to amend Section 13 of Schedule A to the By-Laws of the NASD to increase the amounts charged by the NASD for its review of certain advertisements and sales literature became effective upon filing. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 18. (Rel. 34-33902)

A proposed rule change (SR-NASD-94-20) filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers to amend Schedule B to the By-Laws of the NASD by changing the boundaries of NASD District 2 to include all Pacific territories and possessions of the United States became effective upon filing. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 18. (Rel. 34-33903)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
