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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### DIVISION OF CORPORATION FINANCE ANNOUNCES TERMINATION DATE FOR EARLY REVIEW PROXY PROGRAM

With the conclusion of the 1994 proxy season, the Division of Corporation Finance has established September 2, 1994 as the last day for submitting draft executive compensation disclosure for review prior to filing with the Commission. Until that date, drafts may continue to be submitted to the attention of John Bernas of the Division of Corporation Finance by facsimile to (202) 272-7546 or by mail to the Securities & Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20549, mail stop 3-4. Issuers submitting the information on EDGAR should use the document tag <CORRESP> to ensure that the information remains non-public. Receipt of any drafts or related written communications should be confirmed by calling John Bernas at (202) 942-2920 and any questions about this procedure should also be directed to Mr. Bernas.

### EDGAR PHASE-IN LIST UPDATES AVAILABLE TO PUBLIC

Pursuant to Rule 901 of Regulation S-T, registrants whose filings are processed by the Division of Corporation Finance may request a change in the date they become subject to mandated electronic filing on the Electronic Data Gathering, Analysis, and Retrieval (EDGAR) system. The Division publishes from time to time changes and corrections to the phase-in list published in the Federal Register on March 18, 1993 (Release No. 33-6977 (February 23, 1993) [58 FR 14628]). A change to a company's phase-in date is of particular importance to persons or entities filing documents with respect to that company, since generally such persons must file electronically when the company becomes subject to electronic filing.

The updates will be published in the SEC News Digest and copies of the phase-in list updates will be available through the Commission's public reference room. They also will be posted on the EDGAR electronic bulletin board.

In addition, the Division has placed in the public reference room a copy of the phase-in list as of February 23, 1993, with companies sorted by group number. This information was published in the Federal Register on March 18, 1993, with all companies being listed in alphabetical order rather than sorted by group number. 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#### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

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#### PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST GRADY SANDERS, ERICA HULL AND NEW ALLIED DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

The Commission announced that it has instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act and Sections 15(b), 21B and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act against New Allied Development Corporation (New Allied), Grady A. Sanders (Sanders), and Erica J. Hull (Hull), all of Denver, Colorado. The Order Instituting Proceedings (Order) charges that, under control of Sanders and Hull, president of New Allied, New Allied represented on March 3, 1992 that it would open a casino in Black Hawk, Colorado in May, 1992. At the time no applications had been submitted for a gaming license or building permits and New Allied did not have financing for the casino. The Order additionally charges that Sanders was an undisclosed control person of New Allied and, as such, sold or controlled sales of New Allied common stock in the over-the-counter market in violation of the registration provisions of the Securities Act. The Order also charges that Sanders and Hull used funds of New Allied to pay their personal living expenses. The Order charges that none of the foregoing was disclosed.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine if the staff's allegations are true and, if so, whether cease and desist orders are appropriate with respect to New Allied, Hull and Sanders, and whether penny stock promoter bars, disgorgement and penalties are appropriate against Sanders and Hull. ## JAY VERMONTY BARRED

The Commission has instituted public administrative proceedings against Jay M. Vermonty (Vermonty), a former principal of Wall Street West, Inc., a broker-dealer previously registered with the Commission. Simultaneous with the institution of these proceedings, the Commission accepted Vermonty's Offer of Settlement, in which he consented to the issuance of an order barring him from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. The bar is based upon an injunction entered against Vermonty in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas (SEC v. Glenn A. Schuster, et al., H-92-3598) that permanently enjoins him from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

The Commission's complaint alleged that Vermonty participated in a fraudulent manipulation of the securities of Bancus Richmond, Inc. (Bancus), by establishing a nominee securities account through which he conducted trades in furtherance of the Bancus distribution. Vermonty consented to the entry of the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's complaint. (Rel. 34-34275)

## COMMISSION FILES ACTION AGAINST MATTHEW KLENOVIC, THOMAS YEARMES and CHRISTOPHER VELTMANN

The Commission announced that it filed a complaint seeking permanent injunctive and other relief in the United States District Court, Middle District of Florida, against Matthew Klenovic, Thomas Yearms and Christopher Veltmann. The Commission's complaint alleges that between December 1987 and April 1991 the defendants engaged in a scheme while serving as management of Standard Oil and Exploration of Delaware, Inc. (STDO), an oil and gas company not associated with Standard Oil of Delaware.

The complaint alleges that the defendants violated antifraud and reporting provisions by misstating and omitting material information regarding STDO's financial status and management in its required reports; violated registration and distribution requirements by selling unregistered shares of STDO stock while not filing required disclosure documents regarding their beneficial ownership of it; and that Klenovic and Yearms violated antifraud provisions by misappropriating over \$1.8 million dollars of investor funds. The complaint alleges that Klenovic violated reporting rules by generating false accounting records and providing them to auditors while Veltmann violated transfer agent regulations in managing Sarasota Trust and Transfer, STDO's transfer agent from 1989 through 1991. [SEC v. Klenovic, Yearms and Veltmann, Civil Action No. 94-909-Civ-T-23A, MD Fla.] (LR-14128)

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of 15 issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. (Rel. 34-34305)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-94-3) to amend its net capital requirements for equity specialists. (Rel. 34-34295)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-94-04) to permit non-U.S. issuers to distribute summary annual reports to U.S. holders of Amex-listed foreign securities and ADRs. (Rel. 34-34300; International Series Rel. 678)

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-94-13) to provide for the full implementation by June 30, 1995, of Amex's Intra-Day Comparison System, which will require comparison of Amex listed stocks on trade date. (Rel. 34-34298)
