RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

PUBLICATION OF REGULATORY FLEXIBILITY ACT RULE REVIEW SCHEDULE

The Commission has authorized publication in the Federal Register of a list of rules scheduled for review pursuant to the Regulatory Flexibility Act. The list provides the public with notice that these rules are scheduled for review by the agency and that the public is invited to comment on them. Public comments are due by February 15, 2000. (Rels. 33-7790; 34-42331; 35-27125; 39-2381; IC-2381; IA-1850; File No. S7-02-00)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

FORMER CHA PENSION FUND HEAD CONVICTED FOR VIOLATING COMMISSION INJUNCTION

The Commission and the United States Attorney for the Northern District Of Illinois (U.S. Attorney) announce the filing of a criminal information against John D. Lauer (Lauer) of Chicago, Illinois for, among other things, engaging in acts which violated a prior Commission injunction. Lauer, the former director of risk management for the Chicago Housing Authority (CHA), had previously been enjoined by the Commission on October 24, 1995, for investing more than \$14 million of CHA pension funds in fictitious "prime-bank" instruments in exchange for more than \$4 million dollars in undisclosed kickbacks by the promoters of the prime-bank note program. Also in October 1995, the U.S. Attorney convicted Lauer for mail fraud, wire fraud and obstructing the Commission's investigation relating to the CHA fraud. The current information, charges Lauer with two counts of mail fraud and one count of wire fraud for engaging in three additional schemes to defraud pending the beginning of his criminal sentence for his prior scheme. On November 30, 1999, Lauer pleaded guilty to the acts alleged in the information and is scheduled to be resentenced for his original crimes, his new activity and his violation of the Commission's injunction. LYNNE MERCER PERMANENTLY ENJOINED AND ORDERED TO PAY DISGORGEMENT AND PENALTIES

The Commission announced that on January 5, Lynne K. Mercer, a Bountiful, Utah, accountant, was permanently enjoined and ordered to pay disgorgement and civil penalties. The Commission's action charged Mercer with forging the signature of his former partner on audit opinions for the financial statements of three publicly-held companies: Computerized Thermal Imaging, Inc., Son-Tech, Inc., and Technology Selection, Inc. In issuing these audit opinions Mercer signed the name of Ted H. Pierce & Associates, an American Fork, Utah, accounting firm, without the firm's knowledge or authorization. The State of Utah revoked Mercer's license as a certified public accountant in 1992. The permanent injunction prohibits Mercer from committing future violations of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Mercer was also ordered to disgorge \$5,855, representing the fees he received from the wrongful audits, and a penalty of \$5,855. Mercer consented to the injunction and monetary remedies without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations. [SEC v. Lynne K. Mercer, U.S.D.C., D. Utah No. 1:99CV00029S] (LR-16409)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CITYFED FINANCIAL CORP.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 8, 2000, to request a hearing on an application filed by CityFed Financial Corp. (CityFed). The requested order would exempt CityFed from all provisions of the Act except Sections 9, 17(a) (modified as discussed in the application), 17(d) (modified as discussed in the application), 17(e), 17(f), 36 through 45, and 47 through 51 of the Act and the rules thereunder, until the earlier of one year from the date of the requested order or such time as CityFed would no longer be required to register as an investment company under the Act. The order would extend an exemption granted until February 12, 2000. (Rel. IC-24252 - January 13)

THE WACHOVIA FUNDS AND WACHOVIA BANK, N.A.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 7, 2000 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Wachovia Funds and Wachovia Bank, N.A. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Section 15(a) of the Act and Rule 18f-2 under the Act. The order would permit applicants to enter into and materially amend subadvisory agreements without shareholder approval and grant relief from certain disclosure requirements. (Rel. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

National Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-99-13) under Section 19(b)(1) of the Exchange Act. The proposed rule change allows NSCC to charge members who use NSCC's Insurance Processing Service transaction and file fees for the transmission of test and production files. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 17. (Rel. 34-42336)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted under Rule 19b-4 by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-98-32) to exclude independently-prepared research reports from the filing requirements of NASD Rule 2210. (Rel. 34-42340)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted under Rule 19b-4 by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-99-70) establishing a fee for historical research and administrative reports provided through Nasdaq's web sites. (Rel. 34-42341)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-99-59) filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange relating to exemptions for customer executions of 250 contracts or less via AUTOM from comparison and transaction charges and to increase options transaction charges for firms, ROTs and specialists has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act. Publication of the notice in the Federal Register is expected during the week of January 17. (Rel. 34-42332)

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-99-10) under Section 19(b)(1) of the Exchange Act. The proposed rule change, which became effective upon filing, lowered OCC's unit fee for clearance that it charges to its members. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 17. (Rel. 34-42337)

WITHDRAWAL

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 4, 2000, to comment on the application of Enzo Biochem, Inc., to withdraw its Common Stock, par value \$.01 per share, from listing and registration on the American Stock Exchange. (34-42338)

COMMENT PERIOD EXTENSIONS

Pursuant to Section 19(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act, the Commission extended from January 10 to January 24 the public comment

period for Amendment No. 5 to the proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-94-34) filed by the New York Stock Exchange to revise Exchange Rule 92, "Limitations on Members' Trading Because of Customers' Orders." Publication of the extension is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 17. (Rel. 34-42330)

The Government Securities Clearing Corporation filed with the Commission (File No. 600-23) pursuant to Section 19(a) of the Securities Exchange Act a request for extension of its registration as a clearing agency under Section 17A of the Act. The Commission has extended GSCC's temporary registration as a clearing agency through July 31, 2000. Publication of the notice and order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 17. (Rel. 34-42335)
