ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

SEC SUES TALLAHASSEE BROKER-DEALER AND ITS PRESIDENT, ALLEGING THEFT OF CUSTOMER FUNDS

On July 26, the Commission filed a complaint and consent to permanent injunction in an action against a Tallahassee, Florida broker-dealer, Meridian Asset Management, Inc. (Meridian), and its president, Robin McEachin. According to the SEC's complaint, Meridian is a broker-dealer registered with the SEC, and an investment adviser registered with the State of Florida. Without admitting or denying the SEC's allegations, Meridian and McEachin consented to the entry of a permanent injunction against future violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws, an asset freeze, disgorgement of ill-gotten gains, a civil money penalty and other relief. Meridian also consented to the intervention in the case of the Securities Investor Protection Corporation (SIPC) and to the appointment of a SIPC trustee to liquidate Meridian for the benefit of its customers.

The SEC alleges in its complaint that from at least 1998 through the present, McEachin misappropriated at least \$1 million, in large part pension funds, which his customers entrusted to him for investment on their behalf. To conceal his theft, McEachin created fictitious Meridian account statements reflecting the purported contents and market value of his customers' portfolios. The account statements falsely showed purchases of securities in the customers' accounts. In fact, McEachin had either purchased no securities, or had purchased significantly less than reflected in the account statements. The SEC also alleges in its complaint that Meridian failed to maintain the minimum net capital required by law, and that it failed, or is in danger of failing, to meet its obligations to its customers.

The SEC also named in its complaint as relief defendants two companies under McEachin's control, Benefit Plans Consultants, Inc. (BP Consultants) and Consolidated Capital Resources, Inc. (CC Resources), alleging that the companies received at least \$120,000 of stolen customer funds. Both companies consented to an asset freeze and to the entry of an order requiring them to disgorge the customer funds which the SEC alleges they unjustly received.

RAMON OBOD PLEADS GUILTY TO MAKING A FALSE STATEMENT IN SEC INVESTIGATION

Ramon R. Obod pleaded guilty on July 27 to a criminal information filed by the U.S. Attorney's office for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania alleging that Obod made a false statement to Securities and Exchange Commission lawyers in violation of 18 U.S.C. §1001. The statement occurred during a 1996 telephone interview conducted as part of investigation of possible insider trading in the securities of Transport Holdings, Inc. (Transport) before the September, 26, 1996 public announcement that Transport would be acquired by Conseco, Inc. (Conseco). The criminal information alleged that Obod made a false statement when, asked about the reasons for his purchase of 500 shares of Transport stock, he failed to disclose that he had been informed of Conseco's forthcoming acquisition of Transport by a representative of his client, American Travelers. The Commission's previously filed complaint against Obod alleged that Obod, then a partner in a Philadelphia-based law firm, was at the time the head of his firm's Corporate Department, was outside counsel to and board member of American Travelers Corporation, which had agreed to be acquired by Conseco in August, 1996. The Complaint further alleged that Obod learned in confidence from American Travelers President that Conseco was also going to acquire Transport, and that two days later, Obod purchased 500 shares of Transport's stock. Obod settled the Commission's case without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations by consenting to the entry of an order enjoining him from violating Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, requiring him to disgorge his profits plus prejudgment interest, and to pay a one-time civil penalty for a total of approximately \$21,000. FINAL JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST JOHN MANION IN INSIDER TRADING ACTION

On July 21, the United States District Court for the District of Arizona entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief (Final Judgment) against John R. Manion (Manion). The Final Judgment, entered pursuant to Manion's consent and without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's Complaint, enjoins Manion from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Manion is also required to pay \$40,185.91 in disgorgement, prejudgment interest and civil penalties.

The Commission's action was filed on June 22, 1999 against six defendants for insider trading in the stock of Bio-Dental Technologies Corp. (Bio-Dental) prior to the June 3,

1996 announcement that Zila, Inc. would acquire Bio-Dental. Named as defendants were Manion, Rocco J. Anselmo, James L. Rammelt, Ivan Kron, Donald S. Italia and William E. Sklar. Simultaneous with the filing of the Complaint, all of the defendants, except Manion, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to the entry of judgments against them. The judgments permanently enjoined them from future antifraud violations and ordered them to pay a total of \$250,286 in disgorgement, prejudgment interest and civil penalties. [SEC v. John R.
