### PHILLIP D. PARKER APPOINTED ASSOCIATE GENERAL COUNSEL, OFFICE OF GENERAL COUNSEL

Daniel Goelzer, General Counsel, announced the appointment of Phillip D. Parker as Associate General Counsel (Counseling). The appointment was effective January 25th. Mr. Parker will be responsible for the legislative and advisory activities of the Office of General Counsel. Mr. Parker succeeds Linda Fienberg, who was appointed Executive Assistant to Chairman Ruder.

Since January 1985, Mr. Parker has been Chief Counsel in the Division of Enforcement. He previously was an Assistant Director, Branch Chief, and staff attorney in the Division. Mr. Parker obtained an A.B. degree with highest honors in English Literature from Kenyon College in 1970, and a J.D. degree from the University of Virginia Law School in 1975. Mr. Parker joined the Commission in 1975 as a staff attorney in the Division of Enforcement.

### WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY; MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.
