David S. ## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND FREEZE OF ASSETS ENTERED AGAINST GOLDCOR, INC., OTHERS

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on July 15 U.S. District Judge G. Kendall Sharp, Middle District of Florida, entered a Temporary Restraining Order and Freeze of Assets against Goldcor, Inc., Carl W. Martin, Richard D. Brown, and Nitram Corporation. The Temporary Restraining Order freezes the assets of the defendants and restrains them from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The July 15 Complaint alleges that Nitram, Brown, and Martin engaged in the distribution of unregistered Goldcor common stock into the over-the-counter market, generating proceeds of at least \$13 million. The Complaint further alleges that the defendants, by various news releases and other statements, falsely represented that Goldcor was actively engaged in refining gold from the beaches of Costa Rica. A hearing on the Commission's motion for preliminary injunction was set for July 27 at 9:00 a.m. (SEC v. Goldcor, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 88-612-CIV-ORL-18, MDFL). (LR-11808)

## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### PUBLIC FACILITY LOAN TRUST

An order has been issued granting an application filed by Shawmut Bank, N.A., not in its individual capacity, but solely as trustee, on behalf of the Public Facility Loan Trust (Trust), in connection with the Federal government's loan asset sales program.

The requested order conditionally exempts the Trust from the provisions of Sections 10(h), 14(a), 16(a), 17(a) and (d), 18(a), (c), and (i), and 32(a) of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of bonds and two classes of certificates of beneficial interest in the Trust collateralized by certain loans originated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. (Rel. IC-16502 - July 28)

#### MERRILL LYNCH CALIFORNIA MUNICIPAL BOND TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 22 to request a hearing on an application for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 18(f), 18(g), and 18(i) of the Investment Company Act to permit Merrill Lynch California Municipal Bond Trust, et al., and all similar investment companies to be established, advised, or managed by the Advisers or distributed by the Distributor, to issue and sell separate classes of securities for the purposes of establishing a dual distribution system; and from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), and 22(d) and Rule 22c-1 to permit assessment of a contingent deferred sales load on certain redemptions of a class of their securities, and waiver of the contingent deferred sales load in certain redemptions; and for an order approving offers of exchange. #### MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY; WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until August 22 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24685, dated July 28: MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY (MP&L) - subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to waive its right to redeem \$10 million principal amount of the Independence County, Arkansas Pollution Control Revenue Bonds, the 1982 Series A Bonds, during the three-year period beginning July 1, 1988 and ending June 30, 1991. MP&L also seeks authorization to waive its optional redemption rights with respect to the 1982 Series A Bonds if it determines to extend the existing rate period for any additional three-year period; and WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY - subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, to issue and sell up to \$75 million of its first mortgage bonds, in one or more series, prior to December 31, 1989.

#### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-88-19) that would establish, on a six-month pilot basis, a new service known as the OTC Bulletin Board Display Service. The Service will allow NASD members to enter, update, and retrieve quotation information on a real-time basis in over-the-counter securities that are not part of the NASDAQ System. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of August 1. (Rel. 34-25949)

#### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-87-20) to increase the number of Institutional Index option contracts eligible for execution through its AUTO-EX system from 10 to 100. (Rel. 34-25950)
