COMMENTS REQUESTED ON PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO RULE 3a12-8

The Commission is proposing for comment an amendment to Rule 3a12-8 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The amendment would designate as exempted securities, solely for purposes of the trading and marketing in the U.S. of futures contracts on those securities, debt securities issued by the governments of Austria, Denmark, Finland, the Netherlands, Norway, Sweden, Switzerland, and West Germany. Rule 3a12-8 currently provides such an exemption for British, Canadian, Japanese, Australian, French, and New Zealand debt securities underlying foreign futures contracts that meet certain conditions set forth in the Rule.

Comments should be submitted in triplicate to Jonathan A. Katz, Secretary, Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Stop 6-9, Washington, DC 20549. Comments must be received 30 days after the release is published in the <u>Federal Register</u> and should refer to File No. S7-17-88. LETTER TO FEDERAL RESERVE BOARD REGARDING BRAZILIAN LOAN RESTRUCTURING

Edmund Coulson, Chief Accountant, and Linda C. Quinn, Director of the Division of Corporation Finance, have jointly issued a letter to the Federal Reserve Board outlining the staff's position of not objecting to bank holding companies' recording interest received on Brazilian debt as income, provided certain conditions are met and disclosure of the impact of such income is prominent in financial statements. # CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

MONEY PAID TO COURT REGISTRY

On August 15, Standard Chartered Bank, a British bank with branches in New York and Hong Kong, paid \$12,499,879.15 into the Registry of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, pursuant to Order of the Court. The Order, which was issued on August 11 by Judge Richard Owen, directed Standard Chartered to make the payment from accounts controlled by Fred C. Lee and two corporations of which he is the president.

The Commission applied for the Order on August 10 after learning that Lee had sought a declaration in Hong Kong that an earlier order in New York freezing his assets had "no effect whatsoever in Hong Kong" in restraining Standard Chartered from complying with demands for payment of the funds to Lee. The Commission argued that the funds in question at Standard Chartered should be maintained in the Registry of the New York court, to be available to compensate investors defrauded in the insider trading scheme alleged in the Commission's Complaint. At the Commission's request, the court sealed the Commission's motion until the funds were paid into Court. Also, on August 10, Lee's default in filing an appearance and Answer was formally noted on the record in New York. (SEC v. Stephen Sui-Kuan Wang, Jr. and Fred C. FINAL ORDER OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST JOSEPH A. JOHNSON

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on August 8 a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction was entered against Joseph A. Johnson by the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California. Johnson consented to the Final Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's Complaint.

Johnson, a Bakersfield, California geologist, was charged with violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in connection with the offer and sale of interests in a gold mining venture, the Moreland Gold Program. Specifically, the Complaint alleges that, while employed as a geologist-consultant for defendant William M. Moreland, Johnson assigned a value of \$30 million to six dolomite mining claims, which were to be held in trust as security for investors in the event of default by Moreland. The Complaint further alleges that Johnson knew that Moreland was selling gold-bearing material to investors and was using Johnson's \$30 million valuation as a guarantee. In fact, this valuation was based on a cursory one-day geologic examination which was conducted by Johnson in 1979, and which the Complaint alleges was insufficient to form a guarantee. ML VENTURE PARTNERS I, L.P.

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
