The Commission is also considering proposing for public comment amendments to five rules under the Advisers Act that would relieve from those rules' requirements advisers that do not register under the Act in reliance on the exemptions. RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

EXTENSION OF COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RULE 12b-1

The Commission is extending the comment period on Investment Company Act Release No. 16431 (June 13, 1988), which requested comments on proposed amendments to rules 12b-1 and 17d-3 under the Investment Company Act of 1940 and to form N-1A under the Investment Company Act of 1940 and the Securities Act of 1933. The comment period has been extended from September 19, 1988 to 90 days after notice of the extension is published in the Federal Register. Comments should be submitted in triplicate to Jonathan G. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

NASD SANCTIONS AGAINST SECO SECURITIES, INC. AND ITS PRESIDENT REDUCED

The Commission reduced sanctions imposed by the NASD on SECO Securities, Inc., a Denver brokerage firm, and its president, Stanley Richards. The Commission affirmed part of the NASD's sanctions -- a two-day suspension of SECO's membership, a ten-day suspension of Richards as a principal, a requirement that Richards requalify as a principal by examination, and censure of both respondents. However, it reduced fines of \$50,000 and \$15,000 imposed, respectively, on the firm and Richards, to \$10,000 and \$3,000.

The Commission found, as had the NASD, that respondents failed to exercise proper supervision over the firm's San Diego branch office in connection with numerous private securities transactions effected by the personnel of that office without obtaining prior approval from SECO. However, the Commission concluded that the fines imposed on respondents should be reduced in light of the facts that respondents had warned branch office personnel against private transactions, took prompt remedial action as soon as they were alerted to them, and, to some extent, were themselves the victims of their salesmen's misconduct. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALEX. BROWN CASH RESERVE FUND

An order has been issued exempting Alex. Brown Cash Reserve Fund, et al. (Applicants), from the provisions of Section 32(a)(1) of the Investment Company Act to permit them to file financial statements signed or certified by an independent public accountant selected at a board of directors/trustees meeting held not more than 90 days before of after the beginning of each Applicant's fiscal year. ML VENTURE PARTNERS II, L.P.

An order has been issued on an application filed by ML Venture Partners I, L.P. and ML Venture Partners II, L.P., business development companies, and Merrill Lynch KECALP Growth Investments Limited Partnership 1983, Merrill Lynch KECALP L.P. 1984, Merrill Lynch KECALP L.P. 1986, and Merrill Lynch KECALP L.P. 1987, employees' securities companies, for an order, on a prospective basis, permitting the business development companies to co-invest with the employees' securities companies in joint transactions otherwise prohibited by Sections 17(d) and 57 of the Act. Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-88-22) to implement coordinated procedures limiting program trading during volatile market conditions. (Rel. 34-26061); and (SR-NYSE-88-23) to implement, during a one-year pilot program, coordinated trading halt procedures during volatile market conditions. (Rel. 34-26062); and The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-88-34) that would add Section 43 to Article III of its Rules of Fair Practice to require registered persons associated with a member firm to notify the firm of outside business activities.
