# ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

## NASD ACTION AGAINST WALLACE CONLEY AFFIRMED

The Commission has sustained sanctions imposed by the NASD on Wallace G. Conley, formerly the chief financial officer and financial and operations principal of Royce Park Investments, Inc., an NASD member firm. The NASD censured Conley and fined him \$2000.

The Commission found that because Conley failed to treat an adverse arbitration award against Royce Park as a liability when it was rendered, the firm operated with a net capital deficiency, failed to maintain accurate books and records, and failed to file accurate FOCUS reports. The Commission rejected Conley's contention that the award against the firm did not have to be booked as a liability until it was confirmed by a federal court. (Rel. 34-31913)

# CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### INJUNCTIONS ENTERED AGAINST FOUR "GOLD MINE" DEFENDANTS

The Commission announced that on January 29, 1993 the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, Dallas Division, entered final judgments of permanent injunction against Oreo Mines, Inc., Orex, Inc., Bill W. Schmidt and Ralph Jordan. The judgments permanently enjoined these defendants from further violations of the securities registration, broker-dealer registration, and fraud provisions of the Securities Act and Exchange Act. In addition, Schmidt and Jordan were ordered to disgorge \$135,000 and \$49,000, respectively. However, payment of the disgorgement amounts was waived based upon their demonstrated financial inability to pay. Defendants Schmidt and Jordan consented to the entry of the judgments on a neither admit nor deny basis. The judgments against Oreo and Orex were entered by default based on their failure to substitute counsel as previously ordered by the Court. Defendant Oreo was also directed to disgorge \$2 million.

The Commission's complaint alleged that these and other defendants raised at least \$4.2 million from 400 investors through the sale of investment contract securities purportedly involving the mining of gold ore. In July 1989, Schmidt and Jordan, based on the facts of this case, pled guilty to violating the Texas State Securities Act and received probated prison sentences. Each was also ordered to pay restitution to the complaining witness in each case. [SEC v. Oreo Mines, Inc., et al., USDC/ND/TX/Dallas Division, Civil Action No. 3-88-0364-T] (LR-13538)

### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BULL & BEAR CAPITAL GROWTH FUND, INC. BULL & BEAR EQUITY-INCOME FUND, INC.

Orders have been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that BULL & BEAR CAPITAL GROWTH FUND, INC. and BULL & BEAR EQUITY-INCOME FUND, INC. have ceased to be investment companies. (Rels. IC-19302 and IC-19303, respectively - March 2)

THE TRAVELERS GROWTH AND INCOME STOCK ACCOUNT FOR VARIABLE ANNUITIES, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting The Travelers Growth and Income Stock Account for Variable Annuities, et al. from Section 15(a) of the Act. The order permits the implementation of new investment advisory agreements, without shareholder approval, during a period of up to 150 days following the closing of a transaction between The Travelers Corporation and Primerica Corporation which caused the termination of applicants' existing investment advisory contracts by assignment. The order also permits the applicant investment advisers to receive from the applicant investment companies any and all fees earned under the new investment advisory agreements upon approval and ratification of such agreements by the investment companies' shareholders.
