TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN THE SECURITIES OF TECHNIGEN CORP.

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading, on NASDAQ or otherwise, in the securities of Technigen Corporation for the period beginning at 5:15 p.m. (EDT) on May 7, 1993 and terminating at 5:15 p.m. (EDT) on May 21, 1993.

The Commission suspended trading in Technigen Corporation securities because of questions concerning the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, certain contracts or agreements between Technigen Corporation and others; whether Technigen Corporation, its officers or affiliates have distributed and are distributing securities in violation of the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933; and the beneficial ownership of Technigen Corporation securities being distributed. Technigen Corporation is a Canadian corporation based in Vancouver, British Columbia. (Rel. 34-32279)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GLENBROOK LIFE AND ANNUITY COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 2, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Glenbrook Life and Annuity Company, Glenbrook Life and Annuity Company Variable Annuity Account (Variable Account) and Allstate Life Financial Services, Inc. for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order would grant exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Variable Account under certain flexible premium deferred variable annuity contracts. (Rel. IC-19462 - May 6)

COLLEGE RETIREMENT EQUITIES FUND, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c), 17(b) and 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder, exempting Teachers Insurance and Annuity Association of America (TIAA), the College Retirement Equities Fund (CREF) and the College Credit Trust (Trust) from the provisions of Sections 17(a) and granting approval under Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1. The order permits CREF to invest in the Trust and to permit certain proposed transactions between TIAA and CREF by which CREF, through its Stock Account, will acquire an interest in the Trust directly or indirectly from TIAA.

The order further denies requests for a hearing filed by the American Bankers Association and the Consumer Bankers Association. (Rel. IC-19463 - May 6)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

LOUISIANA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 1, 1993 to request a hearing on a proposal by Louisiana Power & Light Company (LP&L), an electric public-utility subsidiary of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company. LP&L proposes through December 31, 1994 to amend its arrangements with the Parish of St. Charles, Louisiana (Parish) to permit the Parish to (a) increase the amount of remaining Parish pollution control bonds (Parish Bonds) to be issued by \$50 million to a total of \$156 million (Total Parish Bonds), (b) issue the Total Parish Bonds on either a tax-exempt basis or, at the option of LP&L, on a taxable basis (Taxable Parish Bonds), (c) convert or refund Taxable Parish Bonds with tax-exempt Parish Bonds (Refunding Parish Bonds) when LP&L receives additional volume cap from the State of Louisiana and use the proceeds from the Refunding Parish Bonds to retire the Taxable Parish Bonds, and (d) purchase additional pollution control facilities for repurchase by LP&L. LP&L also proposes through December 31, 1994 to increase the remaining authorized amount of collateral bonds (Collateral Bonds) to be issued as a pledge for the Parish Bonds by \$70 million to a total of \$215.44 million and to convert or refund and reissue Collateral Bonds as a pledge for the Total Parish Bonds subject to the same terms and conditions as described in this post-effective amendment and authorized by the Orders. THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 1, 1993 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P), a public-utility subsidiary company of Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company. CL&P proposes to make monthly advances through March 31, 1995, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$12 million outstanding at any one time, to Great Bay Power Corporation (formerly known as EUA Power Corporation). The United Illuminating Company, an exempt public utility holding company, will also make advances up to \$8 million. (Rel. 35-25808)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the applications of four exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. The exchanges and number of issues are as follows: Philadelphia Stock Exchange - 10 issues (Rel. 34-32281); Midwest Stock Exchange - 4 issues (Rel. 34-32282); Cincinnati Stock Exchange - 20 issues (Rel. 34-32283); and Pacific Stock Exchange - 11 issues (Rel. 34-32284).

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

REQUEST FOR FULL REGISTRATION OR EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY REGISTRATION AS CLEARING AGENCY

The Government Securities Clearing Corporation requested that the Commission grant GSCC full registration as a clearing agency or, in the alternative, extend GSCC's temporary registration as a clearing agency. On March 1, 1993, GSCC filed an amended form CA-1. Publication was expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 3. (Rel. 34-32252)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Delta Government Options Corp. filed a proposed rule change (SR-DGOC-93-01) to modify DGOC's definition of Exercise Price by expanding the fractional increments from sixteenths of a dollar to sixty-fourths of a dollar. Publication of the proposal was expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 3. (Rel. 34-32263)

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-93-14) relating to the proposed listing and trading of warrants based on the Amex Hong Kong Index. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 10. (Rel. 34-32269; International Series Rel. 544)

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-93-08) to provide for the listing and trading of options based on the Morgan Stanley Cyclical and Consumer Indexes. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 10. (Rel. 34-32276)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-93-27), which the Commission approved on an accelerated basis through November 5, 1993. The purpose of the rule is to extend on a temporary basis operation of a pilot market information linkage program between the NASD and the London Stock Exchange. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 10. (Rel. 34-32267; International Series Rel. 543)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the Midwest Stock Exchange to amend its Membership Dues and Fees (SR-MSE-93-7) has become effective upon filing with the Commission. (Rel. 34-32268)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
