NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

CHANGE IN THE MEETING: DELETION

An open meeting scheduled for Friday, July 23, at 10:00 a.m. was cancelled. The item which was to be considered follows:

Consideration of whether to adopt Rules 53, 54 and 57, under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935. Rule 53 defines a partial safe harbor for registered holding company financing of exempt wholesale generator acquisitions, and Rule 54 creates a similar safe harbor for other transactions involving companies in the registered system. Rule 57 prescribes notification (Form U-57) and reporting requirements (Form U-33-S) for foreign utility companies and their associate publicutility companies. The Commission will also consider amendments to Forms U5S and U-3A-2. Further, the Commission will consider whether to publish for comment proposed amendments to Rule 87 to require Commission approval for the sale of goods and construction and services rendered, directly or indirectly, both to exempt wholesale generators and foreign utility companies from, and by such entities to, other companies in the registered holding company system. EDGAR PHASE-IN LIST UPDATES AVAILABLE TO PUBLIC

Pursuant to Rule 901 of Regulation S-T, registrants whose filings are processed by the Division of Corporation Finance may request a change in the date they become subject to mandated electronic filing on the Electronic Data Gathering, Analysis, and Retrieval (EDGAR) system. The Division intends to publish from time to time changes and corrections to the phase-in list published in the <u>Federal Register</u> on March 18, 1993 (Release No. 33-6977 (February 23, 1993) [58 FR 14628]). A change to a company's phase-in date is of particular importance to persons or entities filing documents with respect to that company, since generally such persons must file electronically when the company become subject to electronic filing.

The updates will be published in the SEC News Digest and copies of the phase-in list updates will be available through the Commission's public reference room. They also will be posted on the EDGAR electronic bulletin board. Updates are also published periodically in the <u>Federal Register</u>; see Release No. 33-7003, published in the <u>Federal Register</u> July 2, 1993 [58 FR 35897].

In addition, the Division has placed in the public reference room a copy of the phase-in list as of February 23, 1993, with companies sorted by group number. This information was published in the <u>Federal Register</u> on March 18, 1993, with all companies being listed in alphabetical order rather than sorted by group number.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

DAILY MONEY FUND, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 20, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Daily Money Fund, et al. for a conditional order pursuant to Rule 17d-1 under the Investment Company Act. The requested order would amend an existing order that permits the Fidelity family of funds to operate a joint trading account that invests solely in repurchase agreements, with maturities not exceeding seven days, collateralized by U.S. government securities. The amended order would permit the establishment of one or more new joint accounts, in addition to the existing joint account and permit certain entities associated with Fidelity but not subject to the Act to participate in the joint accounts. The amended order would also permit the joint accounts to invest in repurchase agreements with maturities of up to sixty days, rather than the current limit of seven days and permit the joint accounts to invest in various short-term money market instruments and tax-exempt obligations, in addition to repurchase agreements. Finally, the amended order would permit the use of first tier securities, in addition to U.S. government securities, as collateral for the repurchase agreements. (Rel. IC-19594 - July 26)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Mississippi Power & Light Company (MP&L), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company. MP&L proposes to issue and sell up to \$60 million aggregate principal amount of a new series of general and refunding bonds (Bonds) pursuant to a negotiated public offering. Jurisdiction continues to be reserved over MP&L's proposal through December 31, 1993 to issue and sell up to \$50 million aggregate principal amount of one or more new series of Bonds and to issue and sell not more than \$37.5 million of a new series of preferred stock by negotiated public offering or private placement and the granting of an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50. In addition, jurisdiction continues to be reserved over MP&L's proposal through December 31, 1993 to enter into transactions

relating to the issuance and sale of up to \$25 million of tax-exempt bonds, in one or more series and to amend its Restated Articles of Incorporation, as amended, to establish a new class of preferred stock having no par value or a nominal par value. (Rel. 35-25859)
