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CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST KAROLA JAMISON

The Commission announced that on August 16 it filed a civil injunctive action in the U.S. District Court for the District of Hawaii against Karola E. Jamison (Jamison) alleging that she violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The complaint also seeks an accounting and disgorgement.

The complaint alleges that from about March 1988 through November 1989 Jamison, a resident of Hawaii, engaged in a fraudulent investment scheme whereby she offered and sold securities in a purported international loan program, called the Collateralized Funding Program (CFP), raising approximately \$1.02 million from more than 40 investors. Jamison, capitalizing on her husband's high rank in the military attracted investors who were primarily military personnel and acquaintances of Jamison.

The complaint also alleges that, undisclosed to investors, the CFP was really a Ponzi scheme consisting of nothing more than a few failed transactions. Jamison also misled investors concerning the risks of the investment, the non-refundability of commitment fees and the true nature of the international loan program. Moreover, Jamison failed to inform investors that investor funds were commingled with funds in her personal and unrelated business accounts and were used by her to pay personal and unrelated business expenses. GARY DIGIROLAMO AND AIR TECH INDUSTRIES, INC. CONSENT TO PERMANENT INJUNCTIONS

The Commission announced today that on August 13 a Final Consent Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief was entered against Defendants Gary L. DiGirolamo (DiGirolamo) and Air Tech Industries, Inc. (Air Tech) enjoining them from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Both defendants neither admitted nor denied the allegations in the Commission's complaint. The Final Judgment does not resolve disgorgement, prejudgment interest or penalties sought by the Commission against either DiGirolamo or Air Tech.

The Commission's complaint alleges that Hercules Capital Inc., a broker-dealer registered with the Commission, and its president, Craig Medoff, and Air Tech and its president, DiGirolamo, fraudulently offered \$2 million in unregistered securities to investors across the country.

The Commission's action against the remaining defendants is pending. [SEC v. Medoff, et al., 93 Civ. 5573, LLS, USDC, SDNY] (LR-13757)

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST SPECIAL DELIVERY SYSTEMS, INC., ET AL.

The Commission announced that on August 18 a civil complaint was filed in New York against SDS, a Florida based package delivery company; Majzoub, SDS' President; Call, SDS' Executive Vice President; Sharkey, Bivona, Dunphy, Mastroianni, Bonanno, and Dadey, registered representatives (RRs); and, as relief defendants, Masri, Grieco and Odom.

The complaint alleges that the RRs violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws by making material misrepresentations and omissions to customers purchasing SDS. Among other things, the RRs failed to inform customers that they were receiving undisclosed compensation from SDS, in excess of the compensation stated in the SDS offering material.

The complaint alleges that SDS violated the issuer reporting provisions of the federal securities laws by failing to disclose in its periodic reports that it made undisclosed payments to the RRs. Majzoub and Call aided and abetted SDS in these violations by preparing and signing the reports.

Finally, the complaint alleges that Masri, Grieco and Odom received SDS IPO proceeds to which they were not entitled.

Sharkey, Bivona and Bonanno each consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, to the entry of a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief and the issuance of an Order by the Commission that bars them from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEWPORT ELECTRIC CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 9, 1993 to request a hearing on a proposal by Newport Electric Corporation (Newport), an electric publicutility subsidiary company of Eastern Utilities Associates, a registered holding company, to refinance up to \$7,925,000 aggregate amount of outstanding tax-exempt bonds. In order to effect such refinancing, Newport proposes to borrow, on or before December 31, 1994, the proceeds of one or more issues of refunding bonds (Refunding Bonds) to be issued by the Rhode Island Development Corporation or similar governmental agency with tax-exempt authority. To enhance the credit rating of the Refunding Bonds, Newport may obtain bond insurance, arrange for an irrevocable letter of credit, and/or issue one or more series of first mortgage bonds or second mortgage bonds (Collateral Bonds). Newport has received authorization under Rule 50(a) (5) to commence negotiations with various underwriters, representatives, banks and insurance companies with respect to the Refunding Bonds and to the Collateral Bonds. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-93-26) to amend Rule 113(a) (Specialists' Public Customers) to limit the ability of approved persons associated with specialist organizations to accept orders in specialty stocks from certain parties and amend Rule 98 (Restrictions on Approved Person Associated with Specialist's Member Organization) to grant an exemption to the new Rule 113(a) limitation for approved persons. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 23. (Rel. 34-32750)

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-93-30) to adopt on a one-year pilot basis, a measure of specialist performance which focuses on a specialist unit's use of its own capital in relation to the total dollar volume of trading activity in the unit's stocks. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 23. (Rel. 34-32751)

The <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-BSE-93-5) that would amend its Constitution and Rules to provide that members, member organizations and allied members must comply with Exchange requests for information and that continued noncompliance may result in the suspension or expulsion of that member or member organization. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 23. (Rel. 34-32752)

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-93-01) to adopt new Rule 208 on the bunching of odd-lot orders; to rescind Rule 365 on clearing member participation in specialist joint accounts; and to rescind Rule 417 and revise Rules 415 and 416 on the handling of certain accounts by members and member organizations. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 23. (Rel. 34-32762)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> (SR-BSE-93-15) to extend for one year the BSE's Specialist Concentration Policy pilot program. (Rel. 34-32753)
