ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS AGAINST OVER THE COUNTER STOCK TRANSFER, INC. AND CAROLYN SIMPSON

The Commission issued an Order making findings and imposing a cease and desist order against Over the Counter Stock Transfer, Inc. (OTC) and Carolyn Simpson (Simpson). Simpson is the owner and principal officer of OTC, a transfer agent registered with the Commission.

The Commission's Order contains findings that OTC and Simpson had been notified on several occasions that OTC must register with the Commission if it was to operate as a transfer agent for companies with securities registered under Section 12 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act). The Commission's Order also contains findings that OTC had willfully violated Section 17A(c)(1) of the Exchange Act by failing to register with the Commission while performing the functions of a transfer agent with respect to securities registered under Section 12 of the Exchange Act during the period from November 1990 through July 5, 1992.

The Commission ordered, in accord with Offers of Settlement submitted by the respondents, that OTC cease and desist from committing or causing any violation and that Simpson cease and desist from committing or causing any future violation of Section 17A(c)(1) of the Exchange Act. (Rel. 34-32763)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST INTERLINK DATA NETWORK OF LOS ANGELES, INC., INTERLINK FIBER OPTIC PARTNERS L.P., INTERLINK VIDEO PHONE PARTNERS L.P. AND MICHAEL GARTNER

On August 23, the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California held Michael Gartner in civil contempt for violating an asset freeze ordered by the Court in connection with its entry of a preliminary injunction against Gartner and three affiliated entities on June 7, 1993. The Commission had requested that the Court hold

Gartner in contempt because of Gartner's payment of \$19,200 in cash to pay for one month's rent on his personal residence. The Commission also alleged that Gartner violated the asset freeze order by withdrawing \$3,000 from an account in his name and by writing checks worth \$500 on another account. The Commission requested that Gartner be incarcerated until he returns the monies spent in violation of the asset freeze.

Following a hearing, the Court granted the Commission's request and ordered Gartner to restore the money to the frozen accounts by August 30, 1993 or to make an adequate showing to the Court by that date of his inability to make payment. COURT ORDERS FORMER WIFE AND CHILDREN OF EDDIE ANTAR TO DISGORGE PROCEEDS OF INSIDER TRADING

The U.S. District Court for the District of New Jersey ordered Deborah Rosen Antar and her daughters (the former wife and children of Eddie Antar) to disgorge illegal profits arising from Eddie Antar's sale of 300,000 shares of stock purportedly on behalf of the daughters. The ruling was contained in an opinion granting the SEC's motion for summary judgment against Ms. Antar and her daughters. The total proceeds from the sale of stock were approximately \$8,000,000. The amount of illegal profits to be disgorged will be determined in subsequent court proceedings.

The SEC's complaint alleges that in June 1985, Eddie Antar, the former President, Chief Executive Officer and Chairman of the Board of Crazy Eddie, sold the shares knowing that the company's reported earnings had been inflated. In its ruling, the District Court held that "[t]his Court has jurisdiction over illegal profits regardless of whether Eddie Antar fraudulently traded for himself or, instead, generated the illegal profits for his children by using an 'estate planning device' that he created." INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

LTV AEROSPACE CREDITORS LIQUIDATING TRUST

A conditional order has been issued under Sections 6(c) and 6(e) of the Investment Company Act exempting LTV Aerospace Creditors Liquidating Trust from all provisions of the Act except Sections 9, 17(a) (as modified), 17(d), 17(e), 17(f), 30(d), 31, and 36 through 53, and the applicable Rules thereunder. The Trust was formed in connection with the LTV Corporation bankruptcy reorganization to liquidate certain assets assigned by LTV to the unsecured creditors of LTV Aerospace and Defense Company. BERLINER HANDELS- UND FRANKFURTER BANK, ET AL.

An amended, conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Berliner Handels- und Frankfurter Bank (Bank) and BHF Finance (Delaware) Inc. (Finance) from the provisions of Subparagraphs (a)(1) and (a)(3) of Rule 3a-5 under the Act. The amended order permits Finance to offer and sell its commercial paper in the United States and use the proceeds to finance the business activities of the Bank, its parent company, without Finance registering as an investment company under the Act. (Rel. IC-19649; International Series Rel. 576 - August 24)

THE BRAZILIAN EQUITY FUND, INC., ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 10(f) of the Investment Company Act on an application filed by The Brazilian Equity Fund, Inc., et al. The order permits applicant investment companies to purchase securities of Brazilian issuers in underwritten offerings in the Federative Republic of Brazil during the existence of an underwriting syndicate in which the investment companies' sub-adviser or an affiliated person thereof is a principal underwriter. LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the <u>American Stock Exchange</u> to strike from listing and registration Precision Areotech, Inc., Common Stock, \$.10 Par Value. (Rel. 34-32765)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> (SR-PSE-92-13) that broadens its Rule 6.40 governing trading restrictions imposed on financially affiliated market makers to include financial arrangements between market makers and any other PSE member or member organization. The proposal also expands the trading restriction to prohibit financially affiliated PSE members from trading in the same crowd without the approval of two floor officials. Publication of the approval order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 23. (Rel. 34-32775)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>American Stock Exchange</u> (SR-Amex-93-05) to enable the Exchange to list and trade large-size, customized index options, referred to as Flexible Exchange Options (FLEX Options) based on the Major Market, Institutional and MidCap Indexes. Publication of the approval order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 23. (Rel. 34-32781)

The <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-93-20) that became effective upon filing with the Commission. The proposed rule change amends Rule 5.9(c) of the PSE's rules relating to book-entry settlement of securities transactions in order to correct inadvertent references to the Exchange as the "Corporation." Publication of the order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 23. (Rel. 34-32787)

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-93-47) that became effective upon filing with the Commission. The purpose of the rule change is to provide notice of the reclassification of 517 National Market System securities within the maximum Small Order Execution System order size tier levels. Publication of the order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 23. (Rel. 34-32789)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-93-28) that would amend NYSE Rules 35 and 301 to require registration applications for all employees of members and member organizations for admission to the Floor to be submitted to the Exchange on Form U-4 and to require all Floor employees of members and member organizations, members and applicants for membership to be fingerprinted. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 23. (Rel. 34-32788)
