ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

FINDINGS AND A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ISSUED AGAINST KAHLER CORPORATION, HAROLD MILNER AND STEVEN STENHAUG

The Commission today announced the issuance of Findings and a Cease and Desist Order pursuant to Section 21C(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Kahler Corporation of Rochester, Minnesota, Harold W. Milner, Kahler's chief executive officer, and Steven R. Stenhaug, Kahler's chief financial officer. Kahler, Milner and Stenhaug consented to the issuance of the Order without admitting or denying the findings. The Commission found that Kahler violated Sections 13(a) and 13(b)(2)(A) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20, 13a-1 and 13a-13 promulgated thereunder, and that Milner and Stenhaug caused such violations. Kahler's principal business is owning, operating and managing hotels.

The Order contains findings that in periodic and annual reports filed with the Commission in 1988, 1989 and 1990, Kahler used improper accounting practices and made inadequate disclosure that resulted in material misstatements of pre-tax income for fiscal years 1988 and 1989 and, for fiscal years 1988 through 1990, inadequate disclosure of loss contingencies expected to materially affect future operating results. The Commission ordered Kahler to permanently cease and desist from violating Sections 13(a) and 13(b)(2)(A) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20, 13a-1 and 13a-13 promulgated thereunder, and Milner and Stenhaug to permanently cease and desist from causing such violations. This action was instituted on June 24, 1993. (Rel. 34-32916; AAE Rel. 481)

GREGORY MELSEN SUSPENDED FROM PRACTICE BEFORE THE COMMISSION

Gregory J. Melsen, a partner with the accounting firm of Deloitte & Touche, has consented to be denied the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission for a period of nine months, pursuant to Rule 2(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. Melsen was the partner on the audits of 1988 and 1989 financial statements of Kahler Corp. The Commission's Opinion and Order found that Melsen failed to comply with GAAS by allowing Kahler improperly to defer operating losses on a hotel without obtaining sufficient competent evidence that the accounting treatment was appropriate and in accordance with GAAP. Melsen also improperly signed unqualified audit opinions even though Kahler had not made required disclosures relating to the deferred operating losses. (Rel. 34-32917; AAE Rel. 482)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GE FUNDS, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 18, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by GE Funds, et al. for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order would permit applicants to issue multiple classes of shares representing interests in five Funds within the GE Funds group of investment companies, and assess a contingent deferred sales charge (CDSC) on certain redemptions of shares, and to waive the CDSC under certain circumstances. SECURITY EQUITY FUND, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 18, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Security Equity Fund, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act that would exempt applicants from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f)(1), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order would permit certain investment companies to issue multiple classes of shares representing interests in the same portfolio of securities and assess and, under certain circumstances, waive a contingent deferred sales charge on redemptions of shares. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER CO., ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by The Connecticut Light & Power Company (CL&P), Western Massachusetts Electric Company (WMECO), Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH), and North Atlantic Energy Corporation (North Atlantic) (collectively, Operating Companies), each an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Northeast Utilities (Northeast), a registered holding company. CL&P and WMECO propose to determine the mandatory and optional redemption terms of preferred stock (that they anticipate issuing by authority of state order and Rule 52) and redeem such preferred stock in the future without further Commission authorization. Also, the Operating Companies propose, from time to time through June 30, 1998, to acquire and retire their first mortgage bonds (Bonds), notes and preferred stock (Preferred) up to the following aggregate principal amounts: CL&P--\$690 million (\$520 million of Bonds and \$170 million of Preferred); WMECO--\$160 million (\$135 million of Bonds and \$25 million of Preferred); PSNH--\$84 million (\$34 million of Bonds and \$50 of Preferred); and North Atlantic -- \$100 million (\$80 million of Bonds and \$20 million of notes). SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-93-45) to amend Article III, Section 44 of the Rules of Fair Practice to prohibit underwriters and related persons from accepting options, warrants or convertible securities as underwriting compensation if the securities include: anti-dilution provisions with disproportionate rights, privileges and economic benefits that are not provided to investors purchasing the issuer's securities in the public offering; or provisions for the receipt or accrual of cash dividends before exercise or conversion of the securities. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of September 27. (Rel. 34-32940)

JOINT INDUSTRY PLANS
