ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

IDMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING INSTITUTED AGAINST CAMERON EVANS

The Commission entered an Order on October 20 instituting a public administrative proceeding pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Exchange Act against Cameron F. Evans (Evans), the president, director and principal of Pantheon Capital Corporation (Pantheon), then a broker-dealer registered with the Commission. Pantheon employed registered representatives as "independent contractors."

The Order finds that Evans failed to reasonably supervise Donald J. Yott (Yott), a person associated with Pantheon, with a view towards preventing Yott's violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and the Exchange Act, in that Evans failed to establish and implement procedures to safeguard Pantheon's bank accounts that could have been expected to detect and prevent Yott's violations. A judgment of permanent injunction was previously entered against Yott and he was barred from the securities industry. Evans consented to the entry of the Order and was barred from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company in a proprietary capacity. Evans was also barred from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company in a supervisory or managerial capacity, with the right to reapply to the appropriate self-regulatory organization or, if there is none, to the Commission, after a period of two years. The Order also notes that Evans does not have the financial ability to pay a penalty. (Rel. 34-33078)

IOLLIS LAMAR SMITH BARRED

The Commission announced today the institution of administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and the entry of an Order making findings that Hollis Lamar Smith (Smith) violated and aided and abetted violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws and, in addition, that on August 30, 1993, the District Court for the District of Louisiana issued a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Smith which permanently enjoined Stone from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The Commission simultaneously accepted an Offer of Settlement in which Smith consented to the entry of the Order without admitting or denying the Commission's findings.

The Order makes findings that from at least September 1984 to February 1988 Smith was associated with and the head of the Baton Rouge, Louisiana branch office of Stoneridge Securities, Inc., a broker-dealer registered with the Commission, and that during that time, Smith actively participated in a scheme to manipulate the price of the securities of Composite Design, Inc. and CTI Technical, Inc. In addition, the Order permanently bars Smith from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-33079)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

HOWARD BAER HELD IN CONTEMPT FOR FAILING TO PROVIDE AN ACCOUNTING

The Commission announced that on September 15, 1993 the Honorable Milton Pollack, United States District Judge for the Southern District of New York, found Howard Baer (Baer) in contempt of court for failing to comply with the Order of Preliminary Injunction and Other Equitable Relief on Consent (Order). The Order, which was entered by the court on July 26, 1993 on consent, required Baer to provide an accounting to the Commission by August 23, 1993. When Baer failed to provide the accounting, the Commission moved by order to show cause to have Baer held in contempt.

Judge Pollack found that when Baer signed the consent to the Order, he voluntarily agreed in writing, without reservation, to serve a written accounting, and by doing so, he waived any supposed Fifth Amendment right to produce the accounting. Judge Pollack further found that the Order was entered by way of negotiations. Judge Pollack stated: "He [Baer] made a bargain in consenting to the Order. He could have chosen to negotiate a waiver of his Fifth Amendment privilege. He did not do so and instead chose to consent to fulfill the accounting; and he should now be held to that bargain." In ruling, Judge Pollack directed Baer to provide the accounting within 10 days and also fined him \$1,000. [SEC v. Howard R. Baer, Civil Action No. 93-5159, SDNY] (LR-13845)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTHWESTERN NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 19, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Northwestern National Life Insurance Company, NWNL Select Variable Account (Variable Account) and Washington Square Securities, Inc. for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order would grant exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Variable Account under certain flexible premium individual deferred retirement annuity contracts. LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES SOUGHT

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until November 16, 1993 to comment on the applications of four exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. The exchanges and number of issues are as follows: Pacific Stock Exchange - 10 issues (Rel. 34-33096); Boston Exchange - 4 issues (Rel. 34-33097); Philadelphia Stock Exchange - 16 issues (Rel. 34-33098); and Chicago Stock Exchange - 32 issues (Rel. 34-33099).

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-93-17) to amend its rules to extend until January 1, 1994, the PSE's Options Trading Crowd Performance Evaluation pilot program. In addition, the PSE seeks permanent approval of the pilot program. The Commission granted accelerated approval to the portion of the proposal which extends the pilot program through January 1, 1994. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of October 25. (Rel. 34-33094)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-93-38) to permit the listing and trading of options on American Depositary Receipts (ADRs) where over 50% of the world-wide trading volume in the underlying stocks and ADRs occurs in the U.S. ADR market, even if the CBOE does not have a comprehensive surveillance sharing agreement in place with the foreign exchange on which the foreign security underlying the ADR primarily trades. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of October 25. (Rel. 34-33102; International Series Rel. 602)

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-AMEX-93-28) to permit the listing and trading of options on American Depositary Receipts (ADRs) where over 50% of the world-wide trading volume in the underlying stocks and ADRs occurs in the U.S. ADR market, even if the AMEX does not have a comprehensive surveillance sharing agreement in place with the foreign exchange on which the foreign security underlying the ADR primarily trades. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 25. (Rel. 34-33103; International Series Rel. 601)
