ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES EXCHANGE COMMISSION

MARTIN MAY OF BROKERS INVESTMENT CORPORATION BARRED

On November 12, the Commission instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Martin W. May (May) in connection with Brokers Investment Corporation's (BIC) sales of unregistered limited partnership interests.

May, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, has consented to the issuance of Orders by the Commission which finds that he was enjoined from violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 10(b) and 15(c) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 15c1-2 thereunder. The complaint alleges that from about August 1990 through May 1992, May and others conducted 12 unregistered limited partnership offerings, fraudulently raising about \$77 million from approximately 4,000 investors. The complaint further alleges that he variously misrepresented to investors the use of proceeds and business of the partnerships, and also used investor funds as part of a Ponzi scheme.

The Order bars May from association with brokers, dealers, municipal securities dealers, investment advisers and investment companies. (Rel. 34-33186)

COMMISSION SUSTAINS FINDINGS OF VIOLATION AGAINST DOUGLAS BLACK BUT REDUCES SANCTION

The Commission has sustained the NASD's findings of violation against Douglas Conrad Black of Leawood, Kansas. Black was formerly the president of B.C. Christopher Securities Company of Kansas City, Missouri. The NASD had found that Black failed to maintain adequate supervisory procedures at B.C. Christopher to detect excessive trading, failed to properly supervise the activities of a former registered representative of that firm, and permitted a person who was not a registered principal to perform supervisory functions, in violation of Article III, Sections 1 and 27 of the NASD's Rules of Fair Practice. The NASD censured Black and fined him \$5.000. In sustaining the findings of violation, the Commission reduced the fine to \$2,500, in light of Black's attempts to fire the registered representative. NASD DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST RICHFIELD SECURITIES, INC. AND PHILIP DAVIS SUSTAINED

The Commission has sustained the disciplinary action taken by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (NASD) against Richfield Securities, Inc. of Englewood, Colorado, an NASD member firm, and Philip James Davis, the firm's president. The NASD censured Richfield and Davis, fined them each \$30,133.97, suspended Richfield from membership for one year, and suspended Davis from association with any member for one year. The NASD also required Davis to requalify by examination before again becoming associated with an NASD member.

The Commission found that, during an eight-month period, Richfield and Davis charged retail customers unfair and fraudulent markups ranging from 11% to 300% in 79 sales of the common stock of Pop Stop, Inc. The Commission also concluded that Richfield and Davis failed to establish and implement written supervisory procedures to detect and prevent the firm's markup violations.

Given the patently excessive nature of the markups, and the supervisory failure that permitted them, the Commission found the sanctions imposed neither excessive nor oppressive. (Rel. 34-33188)

COMMISSION SUSTAINS NASD DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST DWS SECURITIES CORPORATION, STEPHEN RANGEL AND HUGH LIDDLE, JR.

The Commission has sustained the disciplinary action taken by the NASD against DWS Securities Corporation, Stephen M. Rangel and Hugh M. Liddle, Jr. The NASD found that Applicants misrepresented material facts and omitted material facts with respect to the manner in which offering proceeds would be used in connection with the sale of securities of Dreamwest Entertainment Corporation and of The Corners, a California limited partnership, in violation of Securities Exchange Act Rule 10b-5 and of Article III, Sections 1 and 18 of the NASD's Rules of Fair Practice. It censured and expelled the Firm from membership, censured and barred both Rangel and Liddle from association with any broker or dealer in any capacity, assessed costs, and fined Applicants \$425,000, jointly and severally. The NASD also required Applicants to offer rescission to investors and stated that the amount of the fine would be reduced by any amounts that the Applicants can demonstrate they repaid to customers. Commission sustained the NASD's findings of a violation and orders of censure, bar and expulsion, but reduced the amount of the fine to \$394,550.16. (34-33193)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE AMERICAN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF NEW YORK, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting The American Life Insurance Company of New York, Separate Account No. 2 of The American Life Insurance Company of New York (Separate Account) and Mutual of America Life Insurance Company from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of distribution and mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Separate Account in connection with the offer and sale of certain variable annuity contracts. (Rel. IC-19883 - November 17)

MFS HIGH YIELD MUNICIPAL BOND FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 13, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by MFS High Yield Municipal Bond Fund for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the applications of four exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are listed in the consolidated transaction reporting system. The exchanges and number of issues are: Pacific Stock Exchange - 10 issues (Rel. 34-33213); Chicago Stock Exchange - 32 issues (Rel. 34-33214); Philadelphia Stock Exchange - 16 issues (Rel. 34-33215); and Boston Stock Exchange - 4 issues (Rel. 34-33216).

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> (SR-CBOE-93-28) relating to bids and offers for stocks, warrants, and other non-option securities, and priority and preference of such bids and offers. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of November 22. (Rel. 34-33208)

ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial

interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
