#### ANNUAL NORTHWEST STATE-FEDERAL-PROVINCIAL SECURITIES CONFERENCE

The Seattle Regional Office is conducting its 25th Annual Northwest State-Federal-Provincial Securities Conference in Portland, Oregon on February 27, 1992. This is the longest running of all regional conferences. Representatives of state, federal, provincial and self-regulatory agencies will participate to foster cooperation and information sharing on current enforcement issues.

This conference is in conjunction with a two-day open seminar by the Northwest Securities Institute, whose sponsors include the securities and business sections of the bar associations of Washington, Oregon and British Columbia. # IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-91-49) which has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act. The proposed rule change waives the PSE's transaction, order book and automatic execution charges for trades in three multiply listed options from December 18, 1991 through March 18, 1992.
