COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHAIRMAN BREEDEN TO HOLD PRESS CONFERENCE

Chairman Breeden will hold a press conference on Friday, June 26, at 11:30 a.m. in Room 1C30. At the press conference he will announce the appointment of an SEC staff member as the new senior technical advisor to the Polish Securities Commission in Warsaw.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST CLEMENT MCLAUGHLIN, JR.

The Commission announced that an Order Instituting Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Order) was issued against Clement W. McLaughlin, Jr. (McLaughlin). The complaint in a corresponding civil action alleges that McLaughlin, while acting as a registered representative at various broker-dealers, solicited clients to make investments with Brunswick Asset Management (Brunswick). The complaint alleges that McLaughlin represented to these clients that Brunswick was a money management firm that would make various securities investments on their behalf. The complaint alleges that Brunswick never existed and McLaughlin utilized investor funds for his own personal benefit in violation of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The complaint alleges that, at present, McLaughlin owes approximately \$1.9 million to 18 individuals who tendered funds to him for investment by Brunswick.

The Order bars McLaughlin from association with any broker, dealer, investment company or municipal securities dealer. McLaughlin consented to the findings and sanctions without admitting or denying the findings. (Rel. 34-30827)

ORDER INSTITUTING PROCEEDINGS, MAKING FINDINGS AND IMPOSING REMEDIAL SANCTIONS ENTERED AGAINST CARLOS FONTECILLA

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Carlos Fontecilla (Fontecilla) of Miami, Florida, the former vice president of a broker-dealer formerly registered with the Commission, with its main offices in Miami and Ft. Lauderdale, Florida.

Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Fontecilla's Offer of Settlement. The Offer of Settlement consents to, and the Commission entered findings that Fontecilla violated or aided and abetted violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act, and further finds that a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction was entered against Fontecilla. Also, the Offer of Settlement consents to, and the Commission entered an Order barring Fontecilla from association with an broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company.

The Commission found that Fontecilla violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws by manipulating the price of certain securities by, among other things, presetting aftermarket price levels and failing to disclose the firm's "no net selling policy," which prohibited customers from selling securities to the firm unless they or other investors entered purchase orders of comparable sizes. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST EDDIE ANTAR AND OTHERS

The Commission and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the District of New Jersey announced on June 24 that Eddie Antar (Eddie), founder and former chairman, president and chief executive officer of Crazy Eddie, Inc. (Crazy Eddie), was arrested in Israel. Eddie's brothers Mitchell and Allen Antar were also arrested in the United States. The Antars and Eddie's first cousin Eddie Gindi were indicted by a Federal Grand Jury in New Jersey on June 11, 1992.

According to a Commission complaint filed in September of 1989, the company, at Eddie's direction, falsified financial records resulting in the overstatement of the company's financial condition by tens of millions of dollars from 1985 to 1987. Eddie, the principal beneficiary of the alleged fraud made more than \$60,000,000 by selling his Crazy Eddie stock to the public at artificially high prices caused by the company's falsified financial performance.

After filing the law suit the Commission discovered that Eddie had secretly transferred tens of millions of dollars abroad. In 1990, a federal judge ordered Eddie to return the money to the United States pending the outcome of the Commission's case. In response to the Court's order, Eddie fled the country. While Eddie was in hiding, the Commission obtained a judgment against him for more than \$72,000,000. [SEC v. Eddie Antar, Sam E. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ECHO BAY FINANCE CORP.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 14, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by Echo Bay Finance Corp. for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting it from the liquidation

preference requirement of Subparagraph (a)(2) of Rule 3a-5 under the Act. The exemption would permit applicant to issue non-voting preferred stock and use the proceeds to finance the business activities of its parent company and subsidiaries of its parent company without registering as an investment company under the Act. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
