### MEETING/CONFERENCE TRAVEL

## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### FREEDOM INVESTMENT TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 5, 1991 to request a hearing on an application filed by Freedom Investment Trust, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order would amend prior orders that permitted applicants to assess a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of shares. (Rel. IC-17938 - January 8)

## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

---

### GRANITE STATE ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing The Narragansett Electric Company (Narragansett), a subsidiary of New England Electric System (NEES), a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to \$70 million in commercial paper, through October 31, 1993, in the form of unsecured promissory notes, under an exception from competitive bidding. The aggregate principal amount of all borrowings by Narragansett, either from the NEES Money Pool or banks, as the Commission authorized by order dated September 21, 1990 (HCAR No. 25156), or the proposed issuance and sale of commercial paper, will not exceed \$70 million through October 31, 1993. ## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

---

### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the following: Participants Trust Company (SR-PTC-90-09) relating to the allocation and distribution of collected principal and interest payments on securities held in PTC (Rel. 34-28744); and Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-90-12) which offers deliverers of securities the opportunity to instruct DTC to allocate automatically cash from the deliverer to the receiver where a failure to deliver creates the need for a due bill (Rel. 34-28745). Publication of the notices is expected in the Federal Register during the weeks of January 7 and 14.

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-90-66) that became effective upon filing under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act. The proposal amends Schedule A, Section 1 of the NASD By-Laws. In July 1990, the NASD elected to change its budgeting and financial reporting period from a fiscal year running from October 1 to September 30 to a calendar year running from January 1 through December 31. Consequently, the rule proposes to amend Section 1 to change the effective date of the credit against membership assessments and to credit portions of the fees assessed to the members on a pro-rata basis in a manner which will recognize the change-over to the NASD's new calendar year. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 14. (Rel. 34-28751)
