COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC AND BIB ANNOUNCE ACCORD ON EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION

Chairman Breeden and Anders Sahlen, Chairman and Director General of the Swedish Bank Inspection Board (BIB), today issued a Communique on the Exchange of Information and the Establishment of a Framework for Cooperation between the SEC and the BIB (International Series Release No. 292, June 27, 1991). Citing the growing interest in cross-border investment between the United States and Sweden, the SEC and the BIB recognize the need to enhance mutual cooperation in the administration and enforcement of the U.S. and Swedish securities laws. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

WNC HOUSING TAX CREDIT FUND III

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by WNC Housing Tax Credit Fund III, L.P., a California limited partnership (Partnership), and its general partner, WNC Tax Credit Partners, L.P., a California limited partnership. The application is for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Act. The order would permit the Partnership to invest in limited partnerships that engage in the ownership and operation of housing for low and moderate income persons. (Rel. IC-18211 - June 21)

HUDSON INCOME SHARES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 22 to request a hearing on an application filed by Hudson Income Shares, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18212 - June 24)

PANTHER PARTNERS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 22 to request a hearing on an application filed by Panther Partners, L.P. (Partnership) and Panther Management Corporation (Corporate General Partner) for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The conditional order determines that the Independent General Partners (as described in the application) will not be deemed to be "interested persons" of the Partnership within the meaning of Section 2(a)(19) of the Act solely because of their status as general partners. The conditional order also determines that limited partners of the Partnership who own less than five percent of the voting interests in the Partnership will not be deemed to be "affiliated persons" as defined by Section 2(a)(3)(D) of the Act solely by reason of their status as partners of the Partnership. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
