REGULATION B EXEMPTION OF SOUTHWESTERN RESOURCES,
INC. AND HARVEST FUELS, INC. TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED

An order has been issued temporarily suspending the Regulation B exemption from registration under the Securities Act of 1933 with regard to the public offering of fractional undivided working interests in oil and gas leases in certain Southwestern Resources, Inc. offerings.

An order has also been issued temporarily suspending the Regulation B exemption from registration under the Securities Act of 1933 with regard to the public offering of fractional undivided working interests in oil and gas leases in certain Harvest Fuels, Inc. offerings. (Rel. 33-5686 and 33-5687)

ORDERS FOR PUBLIC PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING AGAINST
SEATTLE, WASHINGTON INVESTMENT
ADVISER AND OTHERS

Public administrative proceedings have been ordered under the Investment Company Act of 1940, the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Financial Management Corporation of Seattle, Washington (FMC), a registered investment adviser, and Robert L. Coate of Tiburon, California, Guy O. Foss of Bothell, Washington, Blake P. Sanborn of Whittier, California, and Beatrice M. Hergert of Everett, Washington. All the individual respondents were formerly officers and/or directors of FMC and of Financial Fund, Inc. (Fund) of Seattle, a registered investment company. The proceeding was also brought against Kay Harrison of Los Angeles, California.

The proceedings are based on staff allegations concerning violations of the antifraud, reporting and recordkeeping provisions of the securities laws, as well as violations of certain provisions of the Investment Company Act of 1940 dealing with the affiliations of directors of investment companies. The order for proceedings further alleges that there were violations of certain sections of the Investment Company Act in connection with the Fund's investment policies, and its failure to redeem securities issued by it. The charges arise out of the handling by respondents of the affairs of the Fund during the period of June 5, 1972 until May 29, 1974 when it was placed in receivership. (Rel. IC-9182)

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

MELVYN B. MASON SENTENCED

The Washington Regional Office and the Philadelphia Branch Office announced that on February 20 the Honorable Eugene Gelfand, Judge of the Common Pleas Court for the First Judicial District of Pennsylvania sentenced Melvyn B. Mason to a minimum of nine months and a maximum of twenty-three months in prison, seven years probation and fines totaling \$14,000 in connection with state fraud charges arising out of a Ponzi Type Scheme perpetrated by Mason from approximately 1962 to 1974.

Mason had pleaded guilty and had been found guilty on the basis of stipulated facts to fraud charges including theft by deception, theft by failure to make required disposition of funds received, criminal solicitation and bad checks. (SEC v. Melvyn B. Mason, 1st Jud. D. Pa.). (LR-7295)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FIRST CALIFORNIA FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 23 to request a hearing on an application of First California Fund, Inc., for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-9181 - Feb. 27)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CONNECTICUT YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company, subsidiary of Northeast Utilities and of New England Electric System, both of which are registered holding companies, to issue and sell short-term notes to banks and/or commercial paper to a dealer in commercial paper in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$35 million outstanding at any one time. MAINE YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Maine Yankee Atomic Power Company, subsidiary of New England Electric System and Northeast Utilities, to issue and sell up to \$21 million in demand notes to banks. (Rel. 35-19408 - Feb. 27)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

EXTENSION OF TIME PERIOD FOR APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has extended the 35 day time period to 90 days for issuing its decision on a proposed rule change filed by the Midwest Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-MSE-76-1). The proposed rule change converts from a pilot to a permanent program an automatic execution formula for 100 to 199 share orders. (Rel. 34-12149)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. has filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-1976-3) to amend Schedule D of the NASD By-Laws by eliminating NASDAQ net capital requirements, amending block reporting requirements, permitting to be quoted certain securities registered under the Investment Company Act of 1940, amending fees for Level I usage, reducing the NASDAQ market maker requirement and outlining procedures on limitation of access to the NASDAQ system. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of March 1. (Rel. 34-12150)

MISCELLANEOUS

GENERAL FELT INDUSTRIES, INC.

An order has been issued denying the application of General Felt Industries, Inc., a Delaware corporation, under Section 12(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 for an exemption from the provisions of Sections 13 and 15(d) of the Act. It appeared to the Commission that the granting of the requested exemption would not have been consistent with the public interest or the protection of investors. (Rel. 34-12147)
