## DECISIONS IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

## U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

JOHN H. WEBER

The Commission has instituted administrative proceedings against and simultaneously accepted the offer of settlement of John H. Weber, Kalispell, Montana, in which Weber, without admitting or denying the allegations of the order, consented to findings that he wilfully violated the registration provisions of the securities laws in connection with the sale of securities of The Major Oil Corporation and consented to the entry of permanent injunction from engaging in such conduct. On the basis of the offer of settlement, Weber was suspended from association with any broker or dealer for a period of thirty days, with the proviso that during the first fifteen days of said suspension he may execute unsolicited liquidating transactions for existing customers and during the second fifteen days of said suspension he may execute any unsolicited brokerage transactions. Weber agreed not to receive compensation for transactions effected during the suspension period. (Rel. 34-12868)

## ORDERS FOR PUBLIC PROCEEDINGS

DAYCON INVESTORS ASSOCIATES, INC.  
JOSEPH P. D'ANGELO

The Commission has announced the institution of public administrative proceedings to determine whether the application of Daycon Investors Associates, Inc. (Applicant), Buffalo, N.Y., for registration as an investment adviser should be denied and to determine what, if any, remedial action against Joseph P. D'Angelo (D'Angelo), is appropriate in the public interest.

The Commission's order is based upon staff allegations that D'Angelo, president and treasurer of and a person associated with Applicant, previously had been enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Western District of New York against violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of the securities of Tycodyne Industries Corp. and that Applicant's application for registration as an investment adviser contained omissions and misstatements with regard to disclosure of that information.

A hearing will be held before an Administrative Law Judge to take evidence on the staff's allegations, to afford respondents an opportunity to offer any defenses thereto and to determine what action of a remedial nature should be ordered by the Commission. (Rel. IA-544)

## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

NEW SEC CONSUMER-EDUCATION BROCHURE

The SEC has released a new consumer-education brochure, "HOW TO AVOID PONZI & PYRAMID SCHEMES," it was announced today. The new brochure is the third such publication developed as part of the Commission's program to assist investors in identifying and avoiding fraudulent investment schemes. The booklet, which is designed to help the consumer in a cautious approach to certain investments, is available without charge from the Consumer Information Center, Dept. 70, Pueblo, Colorado 81009 (refer to Stock No. 600E when ordering). Requests for multiple copies should be directed to the Office of Public Affairs, Securities and Exchange Commission, 500 North Capitol Street, Washington, D.C. 20549.

The booklet explains that the Ponzi scheme, named for Charles A. Ponzi, who defrauded hundreds of investors in the 1920s, pays off old "investors" with money coming in from new "investors." The "pyramid" scheme is essentially a business variation of the familiar "chain letter." In brief, these schemes may be characterized by the following: Reliance of funds from new investors to pay returns, commissions or bonuses to old investors; Need for an inexhaustible supply of new investors; and Absence of a profitable product or of efforts to make profits through productive work.

### AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY

### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. has filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NYSE-76-52) to amend its billing procedures for SEC transaction fees. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of October 18. (Rel. 34-12895)

The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board has filed an amended proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-MSRB-76-9) to require brokers, dealers, and municipal securities dealers to send written confirmation of municipal securities transactions to their customers. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of October 18. (Rel. 34-12897)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE
