ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

EDDIE ANTAR SENTENCED TO FEDERAL PRISON TERM OF 82 MONTHS

The Commission announced that the Honorable Harold A. Ackerman, United States District Judge for the District of New Jersey, sentenced Eddie Antar, formerly the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Crazy Eddie, Inc., to a federal prison term of 82 months followed by 2 years of supervised release. Antar was sentenced pursuant to his plea of guilty to racketeering conspiracy in connection with a securities fraud and insider trading scheme at Crazy Eddie, Inc.

In a related civil case, SEC v. Eddie Antar, Civ. No. 89-3773 (D.N.J.), the court-appointed Trustee is now in possession of almost \$76 million recovered from Antar and others. On September 23, 1996, the SEC filed a proposed plan for distribution to return these moneys to the victims of Antar's fraud. The SEC's motion seeking approval of the distribution plan is pending. The SEC's civil actions against Mitchell Antar, Sam M. Antar, Allen Antar and Benjamin Kuszer are still pending. [SEC v. Eddie Antar, Sam E. FINAL CONSENT JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION AND OTHER RELIEF ENTERED AGAINST LINDA HODGE AND THE HODGE GROUP, P.C.

The Commission announced today that on January 24 the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York entered a Final Judgment on consent against defendants Linda A. Hodge (Hodge) and The Hodge Group, P.C. (The Hodge Group). Under the Final Judgment, Hodge and The Hodge Group, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, are each enjoined from committing securities fraud and they are required to pay, jointly and severally, \$36,144.28 in disgorgement and prejudgment interest. Hodge is also required to pay a civil penalty of \$29,000.

The complaint alleges that in August 1992 Hodge and The Hodge Group prepared and signed a false audit opinion in connection with a fraudulent offering of the securities of Air Tech Industries, Inc. (Air Tech) and that Hodge misappropriated \$29,000 raised from

investors in that offering. Hodge and The Hodge Group are alleged to have violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5.

The disgorgement and prejudgment interest to be paid by Hodge and The Hodge Group will be held by the Court for the benefit of persons who submit valid claims arising under the federal securities laws by reason of the conduct alleged against defendants in the complaint. Such claims must be filed by January 25, 1997.

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-97-06) filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange, which adopts certain enhancements to the CBOE's Order Routing System (ORS) on a pilot basis until May 30, 1997, has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 19b-4(e)(5) thereunder. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 17. (Rel. 34-38261)

A proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange to extend its waiver of transaction charges for FLEX Equity Options (SR-CBOE-97-05) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 17. (Rel. 34-38262)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE AND ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-96-23) to revise the Phlx's options specialist evaluation program, and granted accelerated approval to Amendment No. 1 to the proposal. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 17. (Rel. 34-38265)
