ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ASSET FREEZE ISSUED IN SEC v. W.S. CLEARING, INC., ET AL.

On March 13, the United States District Court for the Central District of California entered a second temporary restraining order freezing the personal assets of William Sedkey Saydein (Saydein). Saydein was the owner and president of the now defunct W.S. Clearing, Inc. (WSC), a self-clearing broker-dealer formerly serving 18 introducing brokers. WSC closed its doors on March 6 because of its net capital deficit of at least \$1.1 million. On March 4, Saydein transferred \$1.9 million from WSC's clearing account to his personal bank account. The Commission sought an asset freeze to prevent the further dissipation of WSC and customer funds. On March 7, the Court issued a temporary restraining order prohibiting WSC and Saydein from further violations of the net capital and customer protection rules, and appointed a temporary receiver to protect WSC's 15,000 client accounts and securities worth approximately \$194 million. On March 12, the Court issued an order appointing a trustee for the liquidation of WSC. The Commission's lawsuit alleges that WSC and Saydein violated Section 15(c)(3) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 15c3-1 (net capital) and 15c3-3 thereunder (customer protection). DANNY STERK HELD IN CIVIL CONTEMPT

On March 4, the Honorable Jose A. Gonzalez, U.S. District Judge for the Southern District of Florida, entered an Order Adjudicating Defendant Danny Sterk In Civil Contempt and Ordering His Incarceration Under Certain Circumstances and Referring the Matter to U.S. Attorney's Office. The Court entered the Order after three hearings were held in January and February 1997 on the Court's Orders to Show Cause why the defendant Danny Sterk (Sterk) should not be held in civil contempt for violating the Court's previous orders requiring Sterk to pay a contempt fine of \$175,000; to file a sworn accounting of his finances; and to pay disgorgement in the amount of \$1,007,783.87.

The actions arise from the complaint filed on August 23, 1994 by the Commission alleging that Sterk obtained funds from investors by misrepresenting or failing to disclose material facts in connection with the sale of general partnership interests in ventures formed to create "wireless cable" television systems. On November 28, 1995 Sterk consented to the entry of a judgment of permanent injunction and other relief.

The Court found that Sterk had failed to establish an inability to pay the sums acquired by the Court orders. The Court ordered Sterk to pay the Receiver the sum of \$25,000 on or before March 15, 1997 and to begin monthly payments of \$2,000 on April 30, 1997, until the disgorgement was paid in full. If Sterk fails to make a payment, he is subject to arrest and incarceration upon the Receiver's notification to the Court. The Court also referred the matter to the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Southern District of Florida for further investigation of possible perjury by Sterk concerning sworn statements made by Sterk concerning his finances. FINAL JUDGMENT BY CONSENT ENTERED AGAINST JAN JUSKO

The Commission today announced that on March 4 the Honorable Judge Joanna Seybert, United States Judge for the Eastern District of New York, entered an Order of Final Judgment by Consent against Jan Jusko (Jusko). The Order requires that Jusko disgorge ill-gotten gains in the amount of \$40,130 and pay prejudgment interest in the amount of \$13,777.91

The Commission's complaint, filed on November 2, 1995, names Jusko as a relief defendant and seeks the return of over \$50,000 that he received in funds that were misappropriated from in or about May 1991 to in or about September 1993 by Frank Duca (Duca), the former chief executive officer of Island Securities, Inc., a registered broker-dealer. The complaint alleged that Duca misappropriated more than \$535,000 from sixteen of his customers' accounts using an elaborate scheme involving, among other things, material misrepresentations and omissions, forged client authorizations, forged endorsement signatures on mutual fund redemption checks, and fabricated account statements. The complaint also alleges that, as part of that scheme, Duca falsely told customers that he would invest their money in "tax-free government bonds" when, in fact, Duca knew that he would not be investing their money in any type of government bond and, instead, gave customers promissory notes in the name of Allvest Corp., an entity with which he was affiliated. From in or about May 1991 through October 1992, Jusko received approximately 32 checks issued by Allvest Corp. totaling approximately \$50,000. For further information, see LR-14709. [SEC v. A proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Stock Exchange to amend the Exchange's SRO fee to provide for an exemption for certain inactive members (SR-CHX-97-05) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 17. (Rel. 34-38397)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-97-18) relating to changes to certain rules to effect compliance with the SEC's Regulation M.
