COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

DATE CLARIFICATION CONCERNING TESTIMONY OF CHAIRMAN LEVITT

Yesterday, the Digest announced that Chairman Levitt would testify concerning appropriations for fiscal year 1998 at the U.S. Capitol Building, Room S-146, at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 19, 1997. The correct date of the testimony is Wednesday, March 19, 1997.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST ROBERT PIERCE AND CARRIE WILLIAMS PIERCE

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings, pursuant to Sections 203(e) and 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 (Advisers Act), against Robert Pierce (Pierce) and Carrie L. Williams Pierce (Williams). Pierce, age 39, has been a registered investment adviser since September 1993. Pierce operated Pierce Investments & Co. (Pierce Investments), an entity through which he provided investment advisory services to clients, from July 1993 through December 1995. Williams, Pierce's wife, was Senior Vice President and Chief Financial Officer of Pierce Investments. The Commission's Order instituting proceedings alleges that, on May 31, 1996, Pierce, Williams and Pierce Investments were enjoined, by default, from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933; Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder; Sections 206(1), (2), and (4) of the Advisers Act and Rule 206(4)-2 thereunder; and Section 204 of the Advisers Act and Rule 204-2 thereunder in connection with their misappropriation of at least \$65,000 from five clients by using clients' funds to pay personal expenses (LR-15298). A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Pierce and Williams are true and, if so, what sanctions, if any, are appropriate and in the public interest. (Rel. IA-1620)

**ADMINISTRATIVE AND CEASE AND DESIST PROCEEDING INSTITUTED AND SETTLED
AGAINST H.P. HAMBRICK CO., INC. AND HENRY HAMBRICK**

On March 18, the Commission issued an Order instituting public administrative and cease and desist proceeding, making findings and imposing remedial sanctions against H.P. Hambrick Co., Inc. (HPH), a registered investment adviser formerly located in Ventura, California, and Henry P. Hambrick (Hambrick), its President.

The Order finds that during 1992 and 1993, HPH and Hambrick violated the investment adviser antifraud and false filing provisions of the federal securities laws by, among other things, using HPH's discretionary trading authority over its clients' assets to misuse those assets and misappropriate approximately \$5.4 million from the clients, and filing a false 1991 HPH balance sheet with the Commission. Specifically, the Order finds that HPH willfully violated Sections 206(1), 206(2), 206(4) and 207 of the Advisers Act and Rules 206(4)-2 and 206(4)-4(a)(1) thereunder; and Hambrick willfully violated Section 207 of the Advisers Act and caused and willfully aided and abetted HPH's violations of Sections 206(1), 206(2) and 206(4) of the Advisers Act and Rules 206(4)-2 and 206(4)-4(a)(1) thereunder.

Simultaneously with the institution of the Order, the Commission accepted HPH's and Hambrick's settlement offer wherein, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, HPH and Hambrick consent to the entry of an order providing that HPH and Hambrick are ordered to cease and desist from committing or causing violations and any future violation of the federal securities laws discussed above; HPH's registration as an investment adviser is revoked; Hambrick is barred from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company; HPH and Hambrick pay disgorgement of \$5,447,958, plus prejudgment interest, but that payment of such amount be waived based upon their demonstrated inability to pay disgorgement; and Hambrick is ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$8,000.

The Commission wishes to acknowledge the substantial assistance provided in this matter by the Swiss Federal Office for Police Matters and the Justice and Police Administration for the Canton of Zug, Switzerland. (Rel. IA-1622)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PENNSYLVANIA MUTUAL FUND

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Pennsylvania Mutual Fund has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-22568 - March 17)

NATIONS FUND TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 11 to request a hearing on an application filed by Nations Fund Trust, et al. for an order pursuant to Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Section 17(a). The order would permit seven series of Nations Fund Trust, and six series of Nations Fund Inc. to acquire substantially all of the assets of The Pilot Fund's fourteen series. Because of certain affiliations, the applicants may not rely on Rule 17a-8 under the Act. (Rel. IC-22569 - March 17)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-97-05) to expand the current exceptions to the requirement that members use the Limited Partnership Transfer Forms for the transfer of limited partnership securities and to require that the Forms be utilized by members when transferring customer accounts involving limited partnerships. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 17. (Rel. 34-38398)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-97-03), which became effective upon filing, modifying receiver authorized delivery procedures and reclamation procedures with respect to payment orders. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 17. (Rel. 34-38404)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-96-36) and published a notice of filing and order granting accelerated approval of Amendment No. 1 to a proposed rule change relating to a one-year pilot program for transmission of proxy and other shareholder communication material. (Rel. 34-38406)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-97-02) to restrict the practice of "intra-day trading." (Rel. 34-38409)

WITHDRAWAL GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of Eaton Vance Corp. to withdraw from listing and registration its non-voting Common Stock, \$.0625 Par Value, on the Boston Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-38412)
