ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST MEMBERS SERVICE CORPORATION, ET AL.

The Commission filed an action against Members Service Corporation, Philip Sung, John R. Silseth II, Union Securities, Ltd., David Gilbert, Todd H. Moore, Charles V. Payne, Wall Street Strategies, Inc., Joseph Lanza, and Kenneth O'Neal alleging violations of the antifraud, registration, and reporting provisions of the federal securities laws. The complaint alleges that, beginning in 1992, the defendants issued false and misleading press releases, prepared false and misleading financial statements, and made undisclosed payments to salesmen and others to manipulate the price of Members stock from \$2.50 to a high of \$12 per share. The complaint alleges that Members, Sung, Silseth, Moore, Union Securities, Gilbert, and Lanza violated Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act, and Rule 10b-5; that Members violated Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20 and 13a-1; that Sung violated Section 13(d) of the Exchange Act and Rule 13d-1; that Wall Street Strategies and Payne violated Section 17(b) of the Securities Act; and that O'Neal, then a CPA, knowingly participated in deficient audits in violation of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5. The complaint seeks disgorgement of illegal profits, civil penalties, and permanent injunctions against further violations. [SEC v. Members Service Corporation, et al., C.A. 97-CV-01146, USDC D.C.] (LR-15371; AAE Rel. 915)

RICHARD K. STEELE, JR. ENJOINED

On May 12, the U.S. District Court for Colorado enjoined by consent Richard K. Steele, Jr., a resident of Dana Point, California, from violating the securities registration provisions of Section 5(a) and (c) of the Securities Act, the anti-fraud provisions of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act, and from selling securities without being registered as a broker-dealer under Section 15(a)(1) of the Exchange Act.

The Commission's complaint alleged that from 1991 through 1994, Steele Jr. and others sold unregistered shares of Balance for Life, Inc. to 82 investors for proceeds of \$1,400,000. They made false statements to investors that BFL's stock would publicly trade on

Nasdaq, the shares would earn \$0.85 to \$2.14 per share in 24 to 36 months, and would soon trade at \$17 to \$45 per share. In fact, BFL did not have sufficient assets for listing on Nasdaq, had no operations, and a loss in 1990 of \$177,000. Prior to January 1993, Steele Jr. was not associated with a broker-dealer.

Steele Jr. was ordered to disgorge \$29,122.50, the commissions earned on his sales. However, civil penalties and prejudgment interest were waived based on his demonstrated inability to pay. [SEC v. JUDGMENT OF NON-DISCHARGEABILITY ENTERED AGAINST KENNETH WIGGINS, JR. AND WIGGINS & COMPANY, INC.

On May 15, the Honorable Samuel J. Steiner, United States Bankruptcy Judge for the Western District of Washington, entered a Final Judgment in the Commission's adversary proceeding which adjudged nondischargeable disgorgement of \$800,500, prejudgment interest of \$631,895.12, and a civil penalty of \$180,500.00 ordered in SEC v. Kenneth Mitchell Wiggins, Jr. and Wiggins & Company, Inc., Civil Action No. C-94-1455WD (W. D. Wash. 1994). Wiggins and Wiggins & Co., without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, stipulated to this final judgment.

The Commission's adversary complaint, filed on July 29, 1996, alleged that the defendants' debt was incurred through securities fraud. See LR-14285, LR-14633, and LR-14748. The complaint alleged that from 1987 through 1993 the defendants raised approximately \$950,000 from 19 investors through sales of interests in nineteenth century Peruvian bonds. When soliciting investors, the defendants misrepresented and failed to state material facts concerning the bonds. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALTIUS-BETA FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 13 to request a hearing on an application filed by Altius-Beta Fund, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-22678 - May 21)

THE LATIN AMERICAN DISCOVERY FUND, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Latin American Discovery Fund, Inc., et al., for an order under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act to exempt applicants from Section 17(a) of the Act, and under Rule 17d-1 to permit certain joint transactions. The order would permit the applicant investment companies (Funds) to lend their portfolio securities to affiliated broker-dealers, to compensate an affiliated lending agent with a fee based upon a share of the proceeds derived by the Funds from their securities lending activities, and to deposit cash collateral derived from the Funds' securities lending activities in one or more joint trading accounts or subaccounts. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CINERGY CORP., ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing Cinergy Investments, Inc., a nonutility subsidiary of Cinergy Corp., a registered holding company, and other nonutility subsidiaries to pay dividends out of capital or unearned surplus through December 31, 2002. (Rel. 35-26719)
