ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

DEREGISTRATION OF BACARDI STOCK DENIED

In an initial decision, Administrative Law Judge Max O. Regensteiner denied termination of registration of Bacardi Corporation's common stock, as sought by a certification filed by the company in May 1987. The proceeding turned on whether at that time the number of Bacardi's shareholders of record had been reduced to less than 300. The company claimed that 238 trusts apparently established to prevent deregistration were not valid and should not be counted. Judge Regensteiner concluded, however, that those trusts were identified as shareholders on records of securityholders maintained on behalf of Bacardi by a transfer agent and were therefore required to be counted.

The initial decision is subject to Commission review on petition of a party or on the Commission's own initiative.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CONNECTICUT BANK AND TRUST COMPANY IRA COLLECTIVE INVESTMENT FUND

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that The Connecticut Bank and Trust Company IRA Collective Investment Fund has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-17342 - Feb. 16)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers has filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-90-6) under Section 19(b)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act to change its rules to add a Section 70 to the Uniform Practice Code to permit the Association to declare clearly erroneous transactions void if they arise out of the use of an automated system operated by the NASD, including specifically the Intermarket Trading System/Computer Assisted Execution System (ITS/CAES). The NASD also proposes to expand the scope Article IX of the NASD's Code of Procedure to cover grievances arising out of the operation of any automated NASD system. Article IX currently

covers grievances arising out of the use of NASDAQ only. Publication of the proposed rule changes is expected to appear in the Federal Register during the week of February 19. (Rel. 34-27711)
