EXCHANGE COMMISSION

CHAIRMAN BREEDEN RELEASES SPEECH

Chairman Richard C. Breeden today released remarks made at the Annual Acquisition and Takeover Institute on Thursday, April 26 in New York City.

RULE 144A

Rule 144A, adopted by the Commission on April 19, is scheduled to be published in the Federal Register on Monday, April 30. The Rule is effective upon publication.

REGULATION S

Regulation S, also adopted by the Commission on April 19, is scheduled to be published in the Federal Register on Wednesday, May 2. Regulation S is effective upon publication.

GAYLA D. SESSOMS NAMED FOIA/PA OFFICER

GayLa D. Sessoms has been appointed as the Assistant Director for Information Services, Office of Consumer Affairs and Information Services. As the Commission's Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act (FOIA/PA) Officer, Ms. Sessoms will be responsible for overall administration of the FOIA/PA Program.

Ms. Sessoms comes to the Commission's staff from the Immigration & Naturalization Service, Information Services Branch, where she worked as a FOIA/PA Program Specialist. Her responsibilities included developing and conducting service-wide FOIA/PA training, monitoring field office FOIA/PA operations to ensure uniformity of compliance, and developing policy for overall administration of the FOIA/PA program.

Ms. Sessoms is currently Treasurer of the American Society of Access Professionals (ASAP) and is a graduate of Lincoln University.

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing The Southern Company (Southern), a registered holding company, and its public utility subsidiaries, Alabama Power Company (Alabama), Gulf Power Company (Gulf), Mississippi Power Company (Mississippi), Savannah Electric and Power Company (Savannah), and Southern Electric Generating Company (SEGCO) (collectively, Applicants), through March 31, 1992 for: (1) Southern to make capital contributions to Gulf in an amount not to exceed \$10 million; and (2) the Applicants

to issue and sell, from time-to-time, up to the aggregate principal amount of \$500 million for Southern, 350 million for Alabama, \$50 million for Gulf, \$120 million for Mississippi, \$40 million for Savannah and \$100 million for SEGCO, short-term or term notes to banks, commercial paper to dealers and/or short-term non-negotiable promissory notes to public entities in connection with the financing of certain pollution control facilities through the issuance by public entities of their revenue bond anticipation notes. MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Mississippi Power & Light Company (MP&L), an electric public-utility subsidiary of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company, to issue and sell, at one time or from time-to-time, through December 31, 1991, to LTCB Trust Company, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Long-Term Credit Bank of Japan, Ltd., a single series of its general and refunding mortgage bonds (G&R Bonds) designated as the 9.90% Series due April 1, 1994, in an aggregate principal amount of \$30 million, pursuant to an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 under subsection (a)(5). MP&L further proposes to acquire: (1) up to an aggregate principal amount of \$105 million of its outstanding first mortgage bonds; and (2) up to \$100 million of one or more series of its outstanding preferred stock, \$100 par value. Jurisdiction has been reserved over other proposed G&R Bonds in the principal amount of \$75 million. (Rel. 35-25078 - April 26)

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-90-10) containing proposals recommended by its Market Regulation Review Committee (Rel. 34-27939); The Cincinnati Stock Exchange (SR-CSE-90-03) to amend its arbitration rules to conform them with the arbitration rules adopted by the Securities Industry Conference on Arbitration (Rel. 34-27940); and The New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-89-02) Amendment No. 1 thereto containing proposals recommended by its Market Regulation Review Committee. The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-90-13) to amend the NASD's Schedule to the Bylaws to require that NASDAQ issuers promptly notify the NASD in writing of any change in the nature of its business or any change of address of its principal place of business.
