CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

BALBOA EXPLORATION COMPANY, APOLLO OIL AND GAS MANAGEMENT, INC., OTHERS NAMED

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action against H. Wayne Hayes, Jr., Balboa Exploration Company, Apollo Oil and Gas Management, Inc. and Harry Winderman on May 3 in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas. The Complaint alleges violations and aiding and abetting violations of the antifraud and periodic reporting provisions of the federal securities laws. It also alleges that Hayes and Apollo, aided and abetted by Winderman, offered interests in an oil and gas drilling program to investors using offering materials which contained numerous misrepresentations and omissions of material fact.

The Complaint seeks permanent injunctions against Hayes, Apollo, Balboa and Winderman, an accounting by the defendants of the proceeds of the oil and gas drilling program and the defendants' assets and liabilities, and disgorgement by the defendants of \$255,000 in unjust enrichment made by them through the oil and gas drilling program. WILLIAM D. FOLZ, ROYAL FIESTA CRUISES PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that, on April 4, the Honorable William Terrell Hodges, U.S. District Judge, Middle District of Florida, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction By Default against Royal Fiesta Cruises, Inc. (Royal) and its president William D. Folz (Folz) of Belleaire, Florida. Royal, a Florida corporation located in Clearwater, Florida, was purportedly engaged in the business of acquiring and renovating a cruise ship to be operated from the Tampa, Florida area. The Final Judgment enjoins the defendants from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws and requires an accounting and disgorgement of proceeds.

The Commission's Complaint, filed January 13, 1989, alleges that Royal and Folz offered and sold approximately \$1.6 million of Royal's unregistered common stock to approximately 270 investors in six states. The Complaint also alleges that Folz misrepresented or omitted to state material facts to investors concerning, among other things, Royal's financial condition, Royal's acquisition and renovation of a cruise ship, the value of Royal's stock and the intended use of proceeds. An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act, declaring that Pacific Horizon California Tax-Exempt Bond Portfolio, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-17469 - May 4)

NEORX CORPORATION

A second notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 25 to request a hearing on an application filed by NeoRx Corporation for an order under Section 3(b)(2) of the Investment Company Act, declaring it to be primarily engaged in a business other than that of investing, reinvesting, owning, holding or trading in securities. A notice of this application was previously issued in Release IC-17328 of February 1, 1990. This second notice is being issued because NeoRx has recharacterized its investment securities and cash equivalents and because, if granted, the requested relief will not be subject to the conditions set forth in the original notice. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

INDIANA ENERGY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 29 to request a hearing on a proposal by Indiana Energy, Inc. (IEI), which is exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(2) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act pursuant to Rule 2. IEI proposes to acquire all of the outstanding common stock of Terre Haute Gas Corporation, wholly owned public utility subsidiary of Indiana Gas & Chemical Corporation, which is exempt from registration by order under Section 3(a)(1) of the Act. IEI also proposes to acquire all of the outstanding common stock of Richmond Gas Corporation, a privately held Indiana gas utility company. IGCC and certain other parties that may be affiliates of IEI and holding companies over IEI as a result of the proposed transactions join in the application. (Rel. 35-25081)

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Consolidated Natural Gas Company (Consolidated) to amend its Certificate of Incorporation (Certificate) and make conforming amendments to its By-Laws, subject to stockholder approval, to: (1) require written notice by a stockholder of a proposed nomination of a person for election to the board of directors (Board); (2) require the written consent of at least 75% of the stockholders in order for Consolidated to take certain actions without prior notice, a meeting, or a vote; (3) increase the minimum stockholding percentage needed to request a mandatory call of a special stockholders' meeting; and (4) require the affirmative vote of either a two-thirds majority of continuing Board members and a majority of stockholders or a majority of the Board members and at least 75% of stockholders to recommend certain changes in the Certificate. (Re. 35-25082)

PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA

An order has been issued authorizing Public Service Company of Oklahoma (PSO), wholly owned electric public utility subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to lease to nonaffiliate companies, from time to time through September 30, 1994, unit trains and railcars owned by PSO. (Rel. 35-25085)
