CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT ALLEGES INSIDER TRADING IN THE STOCK OF MODULAIRE

The Commission filed a complaint, on May 31, against Joseph Behar, the former chairman and chief executive officer of Modulaire Industries, and Adrienne Wailes, the wife of Modulaire president David Wailes, for tipping others to buy Modulaire stock on the basis of material, nonpublic information relating to the proposed acquisition of Modulaire by Waste Management Inc.; and against Donald Carter, Dorothy Carter, Mary Alice Graves, Christopher Scott, Jon Treder, and Charles Devenport (Deven) Wailes for buying Modulaire stock based on such tips, in violation of the Securities Exchange Act Section 10(b) and Rule 10b-5. All defendants have reached settlement agreements with the Commission by which they will collectively pay in excess of \$330,000 in disgorgement and penalties. All defendants paying disgorgement will also pay prejudgment interest thereon. Behar, Donald and Dorothy Carter, Castellucci, Graves, Treder, and Adrienne Wailes have consented to the entry of permanent injunctions prohibiting them from engaging in future violations of Section 10(b) and Rule 10b-5. Christopher Scott and Deven Wailes have consented to the entry of final orders prohibiting them from engaging in future violations of Section 10(b) and Rule 10b-5. [SEC v. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

THREE OEX, INC. OFFICIALS INDICTED

The Fort Worth Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Western District of Arkansas announced that, on May 23, three former officials of OEX, Inc. were charged with thirteen counts of fraud in an indictment returned by a federal grand jury convened in El Dorado, Arkansas. Charged are Gary Wayne Cooper, his wife Sharon Ann Cooper, both now residents of Corpus Christi, Texas, and Mark Stephen Wilson of Fort Smith, Arkansas. All three defendants are charged with one count of securities fraud.

In addition, Gary Cooper and Wilson are each charged with five counts of mail fraud, and Sharon Cooper is charged with one count of mail fraud and one count of interstate transportation of money obtained by fraud.

The indictment alleges that from September 1985 to July 1987 the Coopers and Wilson engaged in a multitude of fraudulent activities in the offer and sale of unregistered stock in OEX, Inc. Approximately \$1.8 million was raised from 144 investors as a result of the defendants' fraudulent activities.

Previously, all three defendants were permanently enjoined from violating the securities registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws, and a receiver was appointed for OEX, Inc. and a subsidiary company. WPL HOLDINGS

The Commission has issued an order: (1) authorizing WPL Holdings, Inc. (Holdings), a Wisconsin corporation, to acquire all of the outstanding shares of common stock of Wisconsin Power & Light Company (WPL), a Wisconsin public utility company and an exempt public utility holding company, and, by such acquisition, to acquire indirectly WPL's holdings of 100% of the outstanding shares of capital stock of South Beloit Water, Gas & Electric Company, an Illinois public utility company, and 33.1% of the capital stock of Wisconsin River Power Company, a Wisconsin electric generating corporation; (2) granting Holdings and its subsidiaries, upon consummation of the proposed transaction, an exemption under Section 3(a)(1) of the Act from all of the

provisions of the Act, except Section 9(a)(2); and (3) denying the request of Wisconsin Environmental Decade, Inc., a not-for-profit, public interest, member corporation, for a hearing on Holdings' application and the request of Wisconsin Public Power, Inc., System to be admitted as a party. THE SOUTHERN COMPANY
CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until June 18 to request a hearing on proposals filed by: MISSISSIPPI POWER COMPANY (Mississippi), wholly owned public utility subsidiary of the Southern Company, whereby Mississippi would issue and sell, in one or more transactions prior to June 1, 1992, up to \$100 million aggregate principal amount of first mortgage bonds and up to \$50 million of new preferred stock, under an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 and Subsection (a)(5) thereunder, and use the proceeds of the sale to pay a portion of its cash requirements to carry on its electric utility business.
