ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ROGER N. ARNOLD CONSENTS TO BAR

The Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Roger N. Arnold of Newbury Park, California. The Order bars Arnold from association in any capacity with any broker or dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer.

The Order was based upon the entry by the U.S. District Court for the District of Kansas of a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction enjoining Arnold from violating the registration, antifraud and broker-dealer fraud provisions of the federal securities laws. According to the Commission's complaint of May 26, 1988, Arnold, while a principal of Equigroup Securities, Inc., a registered broker-dealer, participated in a scheme to fraudulently sell stock in Golden Gate Industries, Inc., a Florida shell company. Arnold consented to the Final Judgment and the Commission's Order without admitting or denying any violation of the federal securities laws. (Rel. 34-28188 - July 6)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

BLINDER ROBINSON

The Commission announced on July 12 the filing of a civil injunctive action in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania against Blinder, Robinson & Co., Inc. (Blinder Robinson), Meyer Blinder and Blinder Robinson's parent company, Intercontinental Enterprises, Inc. (Intercontinental Enterprises). Meyer Blinder is the president of Blinder Robinson, a well-known "penny stock" broker-dealer, and also is the president and chairman of the board of Intercontinental Enterprises. In its complaint, the Commission alleges violations of the antifraud and antimanipulation provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and seeks (1) permanent injunctions against future violations of those provisions, and (2) disgorgement of more than \$20 million in illegal profits, plus interest.

The complaint alleges that, beginning in 1985 and continuing into 1987, Blinder Robinson, controlled by Meyer Blinder and Intercontinental Enterprises, illegally distributed and sold to its retail customers more than 1 billion "penny stock" shares of 12 shell companies which had been the subjects of "blank check" public offerings of securities. The complaint further alleges that Blinder Robinson sold the shares to its retail customers at prices which included undisclosed "markups" ranging up to 140%, and that, under applicable law, undisclosed markups may not exceed 10%. DISGORGEMENT PLAN AND FINAL JUDGMENT AGAINST THOMAS JAMES ASSOCIATES. INC. AND OTHERS

The Commission announced on July 12 that, on July 11, the Honorable Michael A. Telesca, U.S. District Judge, Western District of New York, issued an Order Directing Distribution of \$1,500,000 disgorged by defendants Thomas James Associates (TJA), Brian S. Thomas (Thomas) and James A. Villa (Villa), and also entered a Final Judgment permanently restraining and enjoining Thomas from violating and aiding and abetting violations of certain sections of the federal securities laws; ordering that Thomas not have any relationship with TJA; barring Thomas from association with any broker, dealer, government securities broker or dealer, investment advisor, investment company or municipal securities dealer; ordering the defendants to make payment of the abovementioned amount to a disgorgement fund; ordering the continuance of a asset freeze previously entered by the Court until the defendants have made full payment in satisfaction of the judgments against them; and ordering that the Court's Order Appointing Special Counsel remain in full force and effect. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALLIANCE STRATEGIC MULTI-MARKET TRUST, INC.
