TRADING SUSPENSIONS

AMERICAN HI-TECH CORPORATION SUSPENDED

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that, on August 30, the Commission temporarily suspended over-the-counter trading in the securities of American Hi-Tech Corporation (Hi-Tech), a Nevada corporation, for the ten day period commencing at 9:30 a.m. (EDT) on August 30 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on September 8.

The Commission temporarily suspended trading in the securities of Hi-Tech because of a lack of current information about the issuer and in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, the financial condition of Hi-Tech, its assets, liabilities and equity and its current and anticipated business operations. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST DALE JABOUR AND OTHERS

On August 29, the Commission filed an injunctive action in the U.S. District Court, Central District of California, against Dale T. Jabour, Ronald Lee Thurman and Winston M. Cheong for allegedly violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Jabour, Thurman and Cheong, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint, consented to the entry of Final Judgments which enjoin them from future violations of Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 promulgated thereunder. Thurman and Cheong consented to disgorge \$1,875 and \$3,830, respectively. (Jabour had previously disgorged \$21,800.) The defendants consented to paying civil penalties under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984.

The Complaint alleges that Jabour learned the material, non-public information that MAI Basic was engaged in internal discussions concerning an acquisition of Prime Computer, Inc. and that he told Thurman and Cheong this information. The Complaint also alleges that, while in possession of such information, Jabour, Thurman and Cheong purchased Prime call options and that they knew or recklessly disregarded the fact that the information was material and nonpublic. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

CRIMINAL INFORMATION FILED AGAINST PARENT INDUSTRIES

The Philadelphia Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania announced that, on August 28, a one-count criminal information was filed against Parent Industries, Inc. (Parent), a Delaware Corporation with its headquarters in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, charging them with participation in the affairs of an enterprise through a pattern of racketeering activity.

The information alleges that Parent engaged in a pattern of federal criminal violations including securities fraud, receipt of securities by fraud and money laundering, through the control of shares of stock of International Signal and Control Group, PLC (ISC) and the merger of ISC with Ferranti PLC, a British corporation traded on the London Stock Exchange. The information alleges that Parent violated the Exchange Act by pledging shares of ISC stock to secure financing, falsely representing the value of ISC stock in connection with merger negotiations between Ferranti PLC and ISC; and obtaining \$39,000,000 in financing on the fraudulent pledge of \$32,000,000 shares of Ferranti International stock. The Federal Task Force conducting the investigation received extensive assistance from the Serious Fraud Office of Great Britain. [U.S. v. Parent Industries, Inc., No. 90-00380 (E.D. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THAI CAPITAL FUND

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting The Thai Capital Fund, Inc. from Section 12(d)(3) of the Act and Rule 12d3-1 thereunder to permit applicant to invest in equity or convertible debt securities issued by foreign issuers that derived more than 15% of their gross revenues from their activities as a broker, dealer, underwriter, or investment adviser, provided such investments meet the conditions described in proposed amended Rule 12d3-1. See Investment Company Act Release No. 17096 (Aug. 3, 1989), 54 FR 33027 (Aug. 11, 1989). (Rel. IC-17700 - August 27)
