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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### ACTION AGAINST WHEELER MUNICIPALS CORPORATION AND DONALD WHEELER SET ASIDE

The Commission has set aside disciplinary action taken by the NASD against Wheeler Municipals Corporation of Towaco, New Jersey, an NASD member firm, and Donald R. Wheeler, the firm's president.

The NASD found that respondents charged the executor of an estate excessive markdowns in liquidating the estate's bond portfolio. It was undisputed that the executor, who was the residual beneficiary of the estate, was deliberately using the bond liquidation as a means of compensating Wheeler for the extensive prior services Wheeler had rendered over many years to the decedent and then to his estate for which he had not received any compensation. The Commission stated that it was unable to find any unfairness in the arrangement chosen by the executor to reward Wheeler, or any basis for disciplinary action against the respondents. 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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### COMPLAINT NAMES FLUID CORPORATION AND GEORGE SLAUGHTER

The Denver Regional Office announced the filing of a complaint on September 25, 1990, in the U.S. District Court for the District of New Mexico, seeking a permanent injunction against Fluid Corporation (Fluid) and George T. Slaughter (Slaughter), the president and chief executive officer of Fluid. The complaint alleges that Fluid violated Sections 10(b) and 13(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, 12b-25, 13a-1, 13a-11 and 13a-13 thereunder and Sections 34(b) and 56 of the Investment Company Act by, among other things: filing a false and misleading annual report regarding its financial condition, its subsidiary's capital impairment condition and a reissued audit opinion; filing false and misleading quarterly reports which failed to disclose the Small Business Administration's written demand for repayment of \$1.9 million in debentures issued by Fluid's subsidiary and Fluid and its subsidiary's inability to pay on demand; failing to file a current report to reflect a change in its certifying accountants; and failing to timely file annual and quarterly reports, as well as notification of late filing on Form 12b-25, with the Commission. Finally, the complaint alleges that Slaughter was a direct violator of the antifraud provisions and an aider and abettor of the reporting violations. [SEC v. Fluid Corporation and George T. ## COMPLAINT AGAINST VISTA MANAGEMENT AND OTHERS

The Atlanta Regional Office and Miami Branch Office announced the filing of a complaint, on September 25, in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida against Ventra Management, Inc. (Ventra), Vista Management, Inc. (Vista), Myron A. Baker (Baker), all located in Palm Harbor, Florida, Guido A. Echevarria, Sr. and Bryan W. Miller, Jr., residing in Miami, Florida. The complaint seeks to enjoin the defendants from violating the registration, anti-fraud and reporting provisions of the federal securities laws.

The complaint alleges that between approximately April 1986 and November 1989, in connection with the offer and sale of Vista and Ventra's common stock and warrants, the defendants filed or caused to be filed periodic reports with the Commission which contained untrue statements of material facts or omitted to state material facts concerning Vista and Ventura's assets, revenues and equity. Further, the complaint alleges that the periodic reports filed with the Commission contained untrue statements regarding the status of Vista and Ventra's operations. The complaint also alleges that Vista and Ventra, aided and abetted by Baker, failed to file certain required periodic reports. [SEC v. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### MARKETMASTER TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 2 to request a hearing on an application filed by MarketMaster Trust, Sovran Bank, N.A., and TBC Funds Distributor, Inc. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 exempting applicants from Sections 18(f), 18(g), and 18(i) of the Act to permit them to sell two classes of shares representing interests in the same portfolio, which classes would be identical except for the allocation of certain expenses attributable to a Shareholder Servicing Plan, voting rights, exchange privileges, and class designation.
